Boy Scouts of America Collection (1911-present)

Scope and Content: The Collection contains records from area Boy Scout troops beginning in 1911. The bulk of the material pertains to troop 107 of Decatur, with some material on troop 175 of Clarkston. The Collection contains original charters, membership rolls, applications, individual Scout records and histories. A more recent donation includes items from Troop 55 from Emory Presbyterian as well. The Andrew B. Robertson papers are from a former Decatur mayor.

Organizational History of the Boy Scouts: The Boys Scouts of America was founded in 1910. Scott Candler organized the first Troop, 1 Decatur, in the Southeast in 1911, just one year after the founding of the organization. In later years, the Belvedere Methodist Church took on sponsorship of the troop. Troop 1 was assigned a new number, 107, in 1934 as metro Atlanta grew and expanded. The troop continues to be one of the largest troops in the area. Troop 175 was formed in 1943, and also continues today.

Description: The Boy Scouts of America Collection contains attendance and dues records, financial records, Scout medical records, troop charters, handbooks, newspaper articles, correspondence, publications, and histories. The material is categorized as much as possible. Folders are organized with general Boy Scouts information first, troop 107 information second, troop 175 information third, and Cub Scouts information last.
