**Description:** The DeKalb County Bond Commission collection is minutes of meetings that cover 1962 through 1973. There is a variety of documents included. There are reports on projects approved, ones under construction and those completed; road projects and what was done, such as resurfacing, curbs or sidewalks, and park improvements such as landscaping, ball fields and studies for improvements. Meeting minutes include board members present, county representatives present, presentations by various county officials on possible projects and sometimes letters from citizens.
