Organizational History of Executive Club of Decatur: The Executive Club of Decatur began when a group of businessmen gathered in August 1962 with the purpose of exploring the possibility of a non-profit corporation similar to the Commerce Club in Atlanta at the time. The ultimate purpose is stating in the club's history, "to provide dining facilities for its members." A board of twelve directors was selected and a facility was looked at located at the north end of the 8th floor of the Decatur Federal building. Meetings were held at least once a month and there were initiation as well as annual dues. There were committees for Finance, house, entertainment and secret membership for possible recruits to the club.

Description: The Executive Club Collection arrived in a series of notebooks. The documents have been processed and those notebooks' contents kept together, even when years overlap. Consequently, there are several groups of folders for 1988. This is to preserve the original order. There is insurance information, rental agreements, member and director minutes, financial information and correspondence. There are even three 8 x 10 color photographs of an organization dinner. There is a flyer announcing that the Executive Club will be providing "light lunch items" in the lobby of the Decatur Federal Building, where they leased space. As of 2011, Wells Fargo is now in the Decatur Federal Building. The collection was donated by a member and former president of the club, Margaret Fairleigh.
