Size: Ten folders.

Organizational History of the Georgia Federation of Women's Clubs: The club began in 1966 with a meeting on June 14. The group was also known as the 4th District Dean's Cabinet. The state is divided into 10 districts. Kitty Stewart was nominated to be the first president. The group helped in setting up DeKalb's libraries and is the owner and operator of Tallulah Falls School in north Georgia. Presidents of local women's clubs, who make up the membership, announce projects and events they are working on. Guest speakers were a part of most meetings and the group attended state and district meetings as well. A 1984 article reported the Georgia Federation as having 8000 members, 5000 is the number given on the current website. In 2013, the group's webpage places the main organization in Tallulah Falls.

Description: The Georgia Federation of Women's Clubs collection is primarily minutes. There is a small amount of correspondence and some member lists.
