Description

David Manley's grandfather ran a store and farm in Decatur on Sycamore Drive, and invented a plow, patented in 1916. The information about Trentham A. Allen is all military related and it is unclear if there is a relation between Allen and Manley. The I.A. Manley registers are very fragile and cannot be extensively handled.
