I don't think they owned a pony, so I think that either it was the living prop of a traveling photographer or it belonged to a friend or relative who brought it over for Evelyn's entertainment.

I wish the printing on the truck were clearer, but it did say "Gazaway & Son Dairy." The "& Son" was my half-brother, Frank Marion Gazaway, Sr., who would have been 23 years old at the time. I believe that the dairy was actually located on Gresham Road. Several years later they relocated to Clifton Springs, where the dairy remained until 1957, when my father retired and died shortly afterward.
