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Introduction

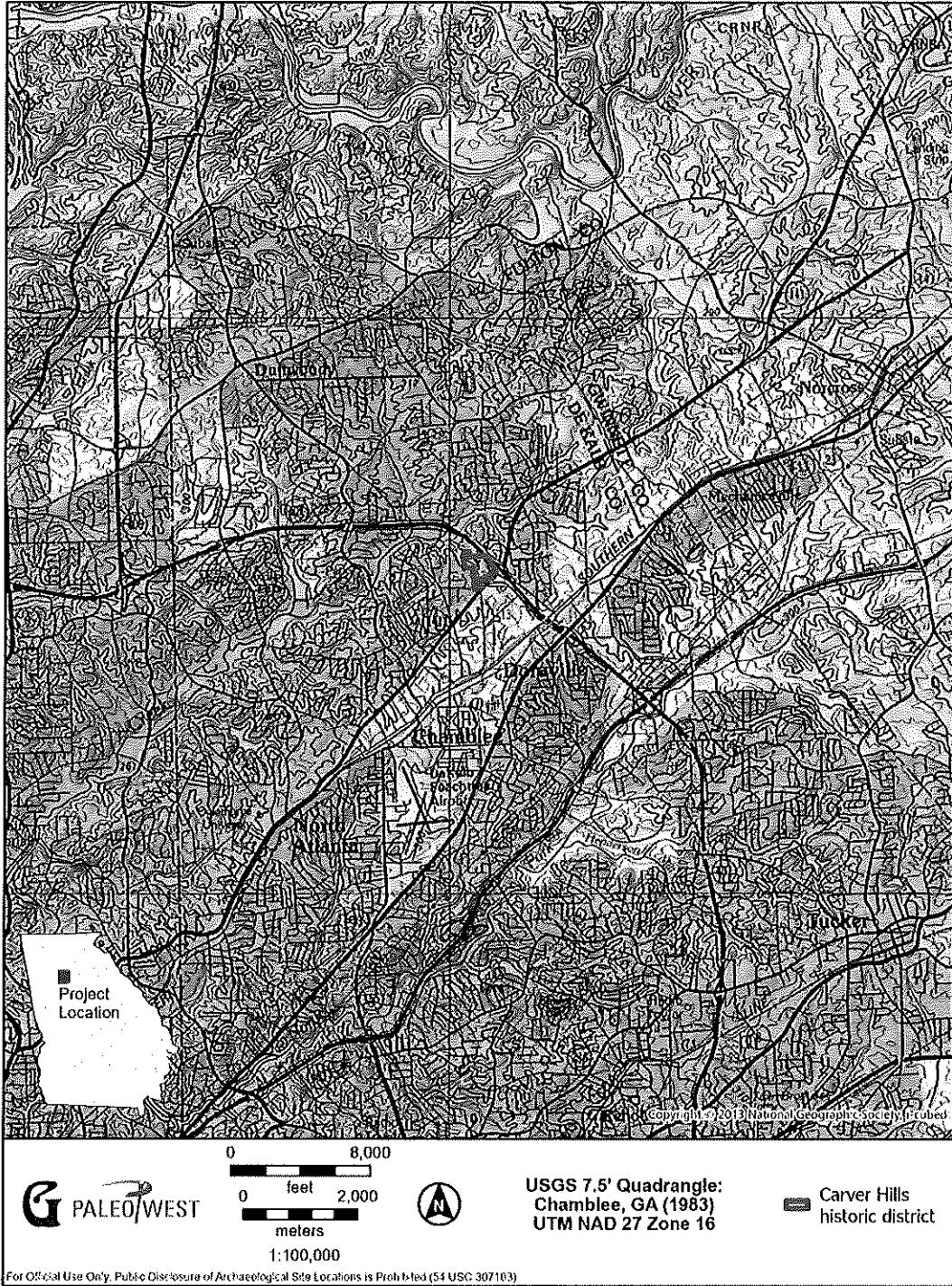


Figure 1. Location of Carver Hills historic district within DeKalb County, Georgia.

This Photographic Permanent Archival Record (PAR) was prepared in accordance with Stipulation 1 of the *Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) Among United States Army Corps Of Engineers (Corps), Georgia State Historic Preservation Officer (GA SHPO), and Toll Southeast LP Company, Inc for the Chamblee Park Assemblage Residential Development, DeKalb County, Georgia* (SAS-2022-00311, HP-220906-006; Figure 1). The Corps has determined the undertaking will have an adverse effect upon the Carver Hills historic district, generally bounded by North Shallowford Road, Peachtree Industrial Boulevard, Interstate 285, and the rear property lines of houses along Parsons Drive and Deacon Lane in the city of Chamblee, which is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP), in consultation with the GA SHPO pursuant to 36 CFR 800, the regulations implementing Section 106 of the NHPA (54 U.S.C. 306108). Pursuant to Stipulation 1 of the MOA, the following must be completed:

- A. Prior to demolition or relocation of any buildings, representative digital photographs will be taken of each building present within the Carver Hills historic district and include:
 - (1) Main Structures: Exterior views taken at a 90-degree angle to each facade (full front); at exterior oblique (3/4) views, from different angles; detail exterior photographs of historic construction methods, windows, doors and other architectural details;
 - (2) Outbuildings: Exterior views taken at a 90-degree angle (full front facade); exterior oblique (3/4) view, showing other facades; where applicable, detail exterior photographs;
 - (3) Site Plan/Landscape: Photographs showing the main structures and outbuildings in relationship to the surrounding landscape.
- B. The photographer shall comply with the minimum level standards necessary for document retention at GA SHPO pursuant to the *Guidelines for Establishing a Photographic Permanent Archival Record*. A draft copy of the photographic record will be provided to GA SHPO review and acceptance. Upon approval, a final digital and hardcopy will be provided to the GA SHPO, the DeKalb History Center, and the DeKalb County Historic Preservation Commission.

Carver Hills historic district encompasses 47 historic-age buildings constructed between 1953 and 1957, located on Deacon Lane and Parsons Drive in the city of Chamblee.

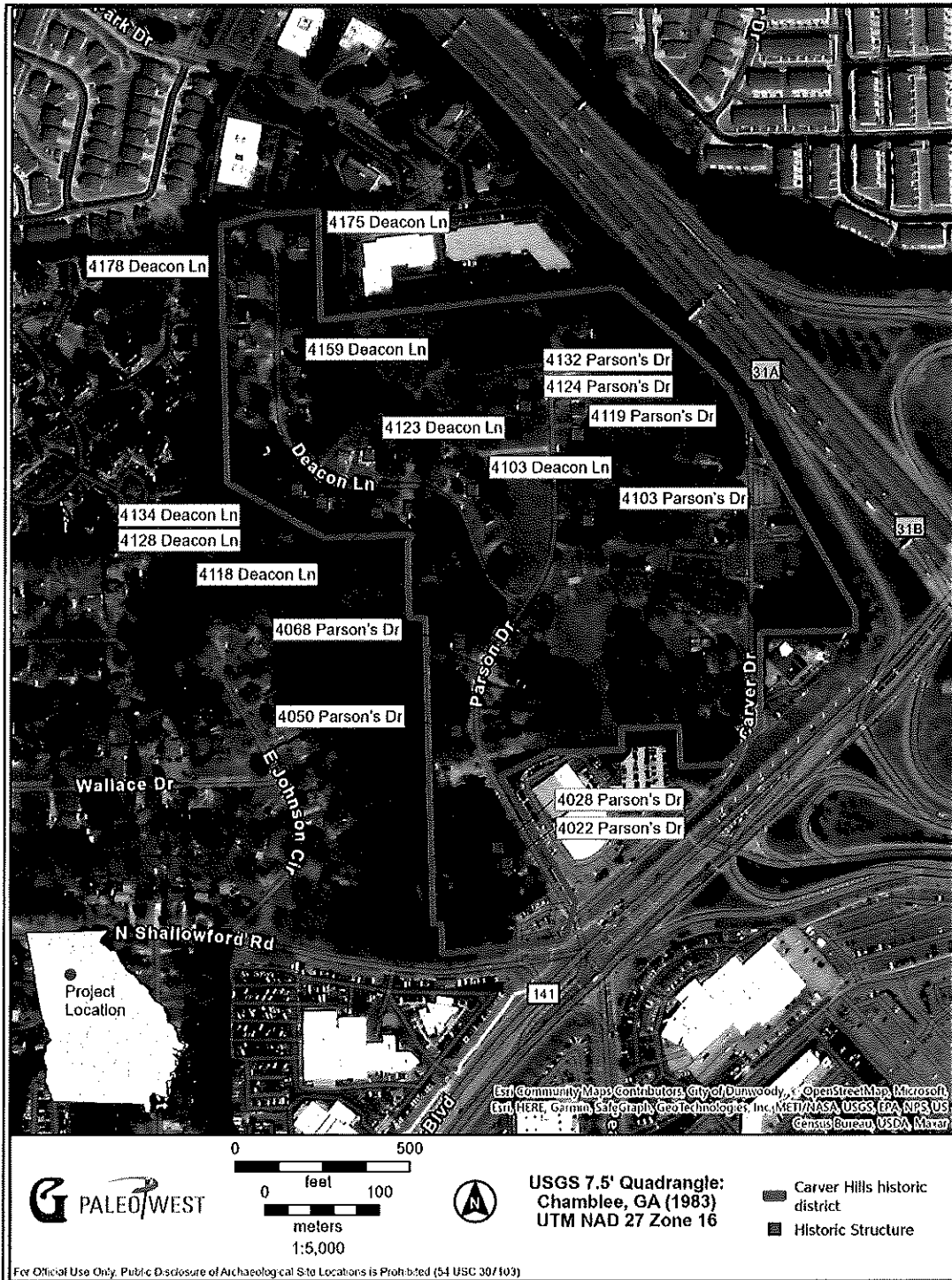


Figure 2. Locations of contributing structures in the Carver Hills historic district.

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The historic district meets criterion A for its association with the development of Doraville after the construction of the General Motors assembly plant and as an innovative model community for African American residents. The historic district meets Criterion C in the area of architecture as an intact collection of mid-century house types and styles including Minimal Traditional style. This PAR documents 16 contributing resources in the Carver Hills historic district inclusive of 15 buildings originally built as single-family and one religious building (Table 1; Figure 2). The building summaries are presented in alpha-numerical street address order.

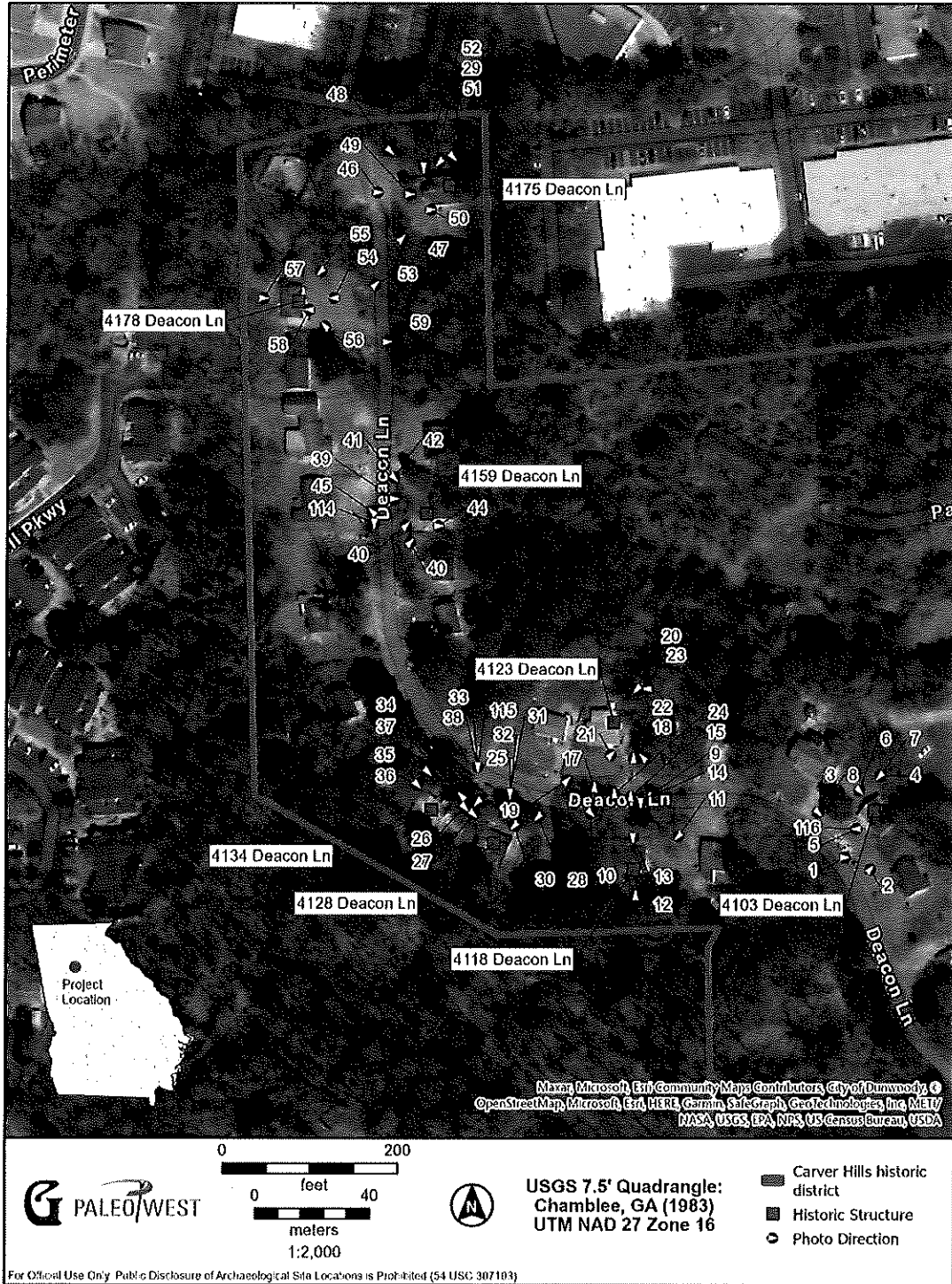


Figure 3. Photo key showing the directions of photos taken of the Carver Hills historic district.

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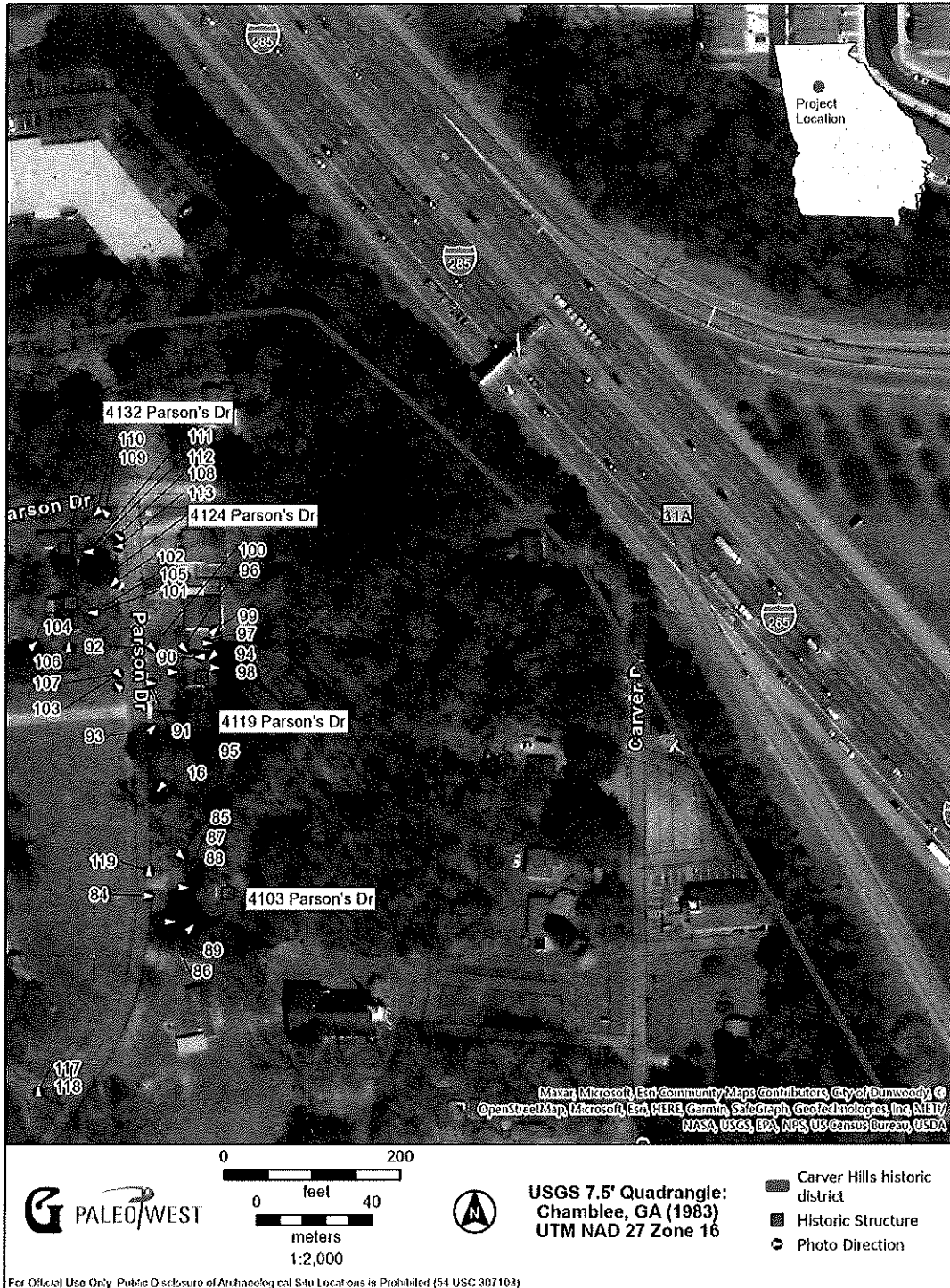


Figure 4. Photo key showing the directions of photos taken of the Carver Hills historic district.

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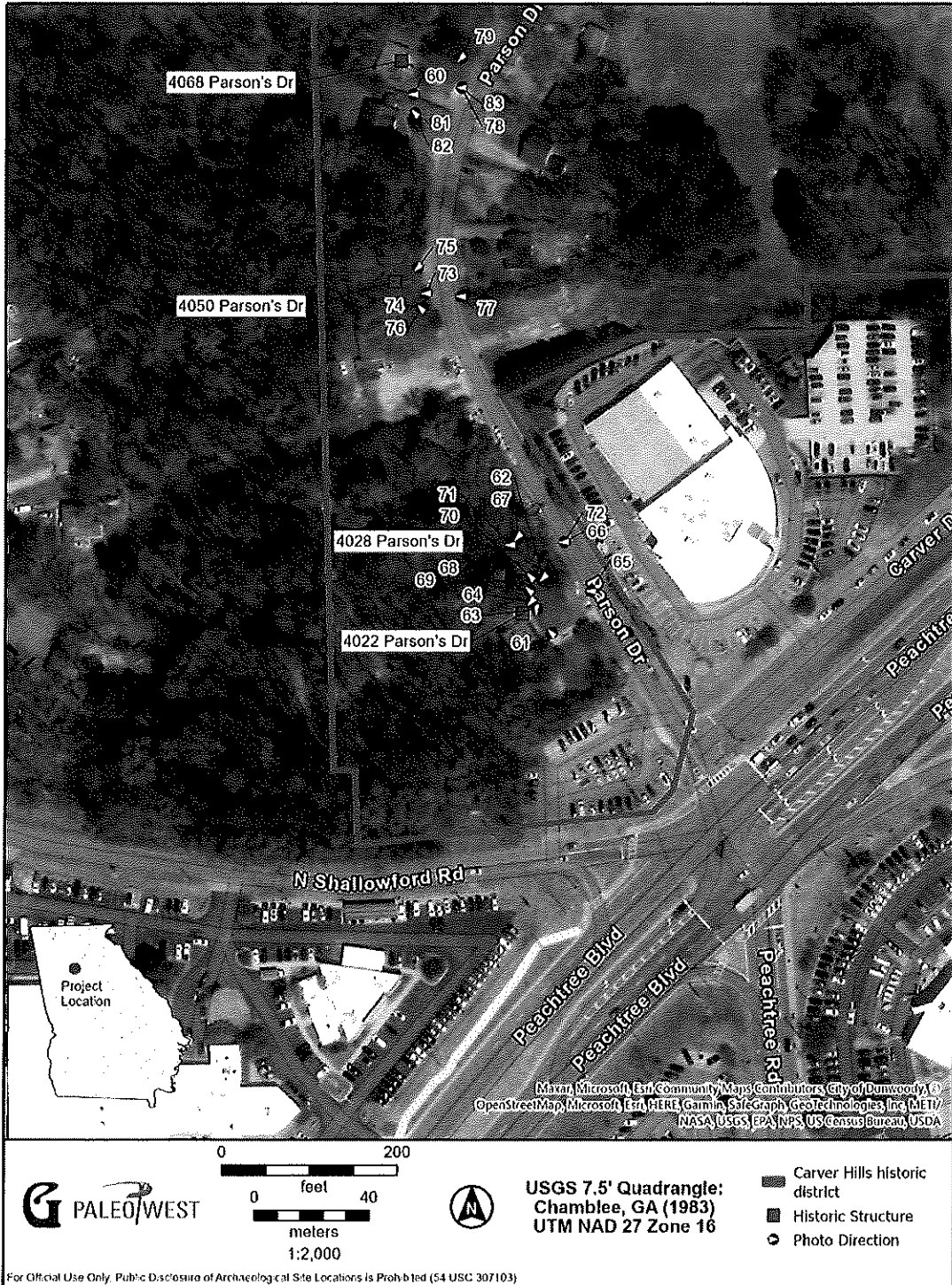


Figure 5. Photo key showing the directions of photos taken of the Carver Hills historic district.

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Carver Hills historic district, Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

UTM Coordinates: 750502, 3755642

Description: The Carver Hills neighborhood was purchased by General Motors in 1949 to provide housing for an African American community displaced by the Doraville assembly plant (Burton et al. 2010). The assembly plant displaced approximately 100 families, and the Doraville City Council would not rezone the site of the proposed plant unless General Motors provided a location for the displaced residents. The company purchased a 150-acre tract of land just north of the plant in 1949, and individual lots were sold for \$2,000. The neighborhood's homes were constructed by several builders and in a variety of popular and affordable post-war styles, including Ranch, Minimal Traditional, and vernacular styles. All residences provided modern amenities, including water and lights, and the neighborhood's streets were paved (Burton et al. 2010; Stokes 2016). One article stated, "[the neighborhoods] is just like adjoining sub-divisions except that white persons cannot buy there. It has a school and Baptist and Methodist Churches" (Atlanta Journal 1949).

In 1960, the Carver Hills neighborhood was bisected by the construction of Interstate 285, leaving a portion of the neighborhood to the east (between I-285 and Peachtree Industrial Boulevard) and a portion to the west (west of I-285 and north of Peachtree Industrial Boulevard). In the mid-1980s, the section of the neighborhood east of I-285 was the proposed site of a new hotel. The possible development began a contentious period in the neighborhood, as some residents intended to sell their land while others rallied against the development (German 1984). Ultimately, a Georgia Supreme Court case resulted in the rezoning of two acres in the neighborhood from residential to commercial. By the late-1980s, more residents were considering selling their land to developers as pressure mounted, and a new interstate on-ramp was planned to cut off a corner of the neighborhood (White 1987).

Despite the contentious debates regarding the development of Carver Hills, the eastern section of the neighborhood remained largely undeveloped until the mid-2000s. In 2016, approximately ten homes in the eastern section of the neighborhood were still occupied, and the remainder had been sold to Century Communities. After a proposed mixed-use development was approved by the Doraville City Council, the eastern portion of Carver Hills was demolished in 2017 (Stokes 2016). The residences on Deacon Lane and Parsons Drive are all that remain of the Carver Hills neighborhood, once described as a "model negro community" (Miami Daily News 1945). Although the homes are currently vacant, and many have had their exterior siding removed and

windows boarded, the neighborhood retains its integrity of location, setting, design, feeling, and association.

The Carver Hills historic district extends northeasterly from Parson Drive to the cul-de-sac at Deacon Lane. Carver Drive and Peachetree Industrial Boulevard (Route 141) are to the south. US Route 285 is east of the district and North Peachtree Road is to the west.

4103 Deacon Lane (Parcel ID 18 334 01 121), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

Current Use: vacant

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4103 Deacon Lane is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has a rectangular plan (840 sq ft,) plywood exterior (exterior siding removed), side-gabled roof with asphalt shingles, and a continuous concrete block foundation. Window openings feature 6/6 double-hung wood sash and a metal awning. The west (front) façade has an off-center entrance with partial porch, a single window opening, and two paired window groupings. The porch has a concrete deck and ramp. Metal porch elements have been removed except for a small section of railing. Side (north and south) elevations have two single window openings and an attic vent. An entry porch is in the north bay of the east (rear) side. The crawl space entrance is on the north side. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4103 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4118 Deacon Lane (Parcel ID 18 334 01 097), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

Current Use: vacant

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4118 Deacon Lane is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has a rectangular plan (984 sq ft), plywood exterior (exterior siding removed), side-gabled roof with asphalt shingles, and a continuous concrete block foundation. The three-bay-wide north (front) façade has an open, half-width porch, an entrance with a wood door (two-panel and six light) in the west (right) bay, and two paired window groupings with 6/6 double-hung wood sash. All single window side elevations are covered with plywood. The rear (south) elevation has a shed roof porch addition enclosed with plywood, a small single window opening with wood 6/6 double hung sash, and a covered entrance door opening. A paved driveway is to the west of the building. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4118 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4123 Deacon Lane (Parcel ID 18 334 01 117), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

Current Use: vacant

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4213 Deacon Lane is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has an L-shaped plan (1,176-sq ft), plywood exterior (exterior siding removed), side-gabled roof with asphalt shingles, and a continuous concrete block foundation. The south (front) façade has an off-center entrance with interior panel door with two small lights, a concrete stoop and metal railings, and two paired 2/2 horizontal wood sash windows. Side elevations feature single window openings (two on the west; three on the east) with 2/2 horizontal wood sash and a rectangular attic vent. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4213 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4128 Deacon Lane (Parcel ID 18 334 01 099), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

Current Use: vacant

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4218 Deacon Lane is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has rectangular plan (840 sq ft), plywood exterior (exterior siding removed), side-gabled roof with asphalt shingles, and a continuous concrete block foundation. The north (front) façade has an off-center entrance, a single 2/2 horizontal wood sash window, and two window openings with removed window sash. Side elevations feature single window openings (two on the west; three on the east) and a rectangular attic vent. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4218 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4134 Deacon Lane (Parcel ID 18 334 01 100), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

Current Use: vacant

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4134 Deacon Lane is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has an irregular-shaped plan (1,000 sq ft), and a composition shingle cross-gable roof with no eaves. Exterior siding materials include vinyl and permastone. The north (front) façade has an off-center entrance with metal canopy supported by metal posts, a single window opening, and a front-gabled-bay with two paired window groupings. All window openings are covered with plywood. An enclosed porch with shed roof and a wooden deck is on the east elevation. A metal carport on the east elevation has been removed. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4134 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4159 Deacon Lane (Parcel ID 18 334 01 112), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

Current Use: vacant

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4159 Deacon Lane is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has a regular-shaped plan (840 sq ft), composition shingle cross-gable roof with no eaves, and a continuous concrete block foundation set. The original exterior siding was removed, exposing plywood and vertical plank plywood. west (front) façade has an off-center entrance, a single window opening, and a front-gabled-bay with two paired window groupings. All window openings are covered with plywood. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4159 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4175 Deacon Lane (Parcel ID 18 334 01 152), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Mount Calvary Baptist Church

Year Built: circa 1957

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1957 building is a two-story vacant religious facility with no academic style. It has a rectangular plan (840 sq ft), concrete block construction, and front-gabled roof. The building's entryway on the west (front) façade consists of a less than full height central entrance bay with front gabled roof, an angled concrete stairway with metal railings, and a wooden access ramp. Original double-leaf entrance doors have been removed. Side elevations have two single window openings at the ground level and five single window openings on the upper level. Secondary entrances to the main floor are located on the northeast and southeast ends of the building. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The former Mount Calvary Baptist Church building at 4175 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant. The building's removed marble plaque indicated the religious institution was organized in 1956, the building was constructed in 1957, and the building plaque "laid" by Clim Davenport, G.M. / F. & A.A.Y.M (Free & Accepted Ancient York Masons).

4178 Deacon Lane (Parcel ID 18 334 01 108), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4178 Deacon Lane is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has a regular-shaped plan (840 sq ft), a composition shingle cross-gable roof with no eaves, and a continuous concrete block foundation. Exterior siding materials include vinyl and permastone. The east (front) façade has an off-center entrance, a single window opening, and a front-gabled-bay with two paired window groupings. All window openings are covered with plywood. Side elevations have two single window openings and a rectangular attic vent. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4178 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4022 Parsons Drive (Parcel ID 18 334 01 086), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1953 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1953 building at 4022 Parsons Drive is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed with no academic style. It has an irregular-shaped plan (798 sq ft), stucco exterior, and a built-up flat roof with wide overhanging eaves. The east (front) façade has an enclosed entry bay with a brick veneer, entrance in the north elevation, window opening in the south elevation, and a flat entry porch roof extension with a decorative metal support. All window openings are covered with plywood. Two small additions have been removed from the north elevation. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1953 building with no academic style at 4022 Parsons Drive is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4028 Parsons Drive (Parcel ID 18 334 01 086), Chamblee, DeKalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1953 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1953 building at 4022 Parsons Drive is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed with no academic style. It has an irregular-shaped plan (798 sq ft), stucco exterior, and a built-up flat roof with wide overhanging eaves. The building's main entry on the south elevation has a low concrete block two-sided entry wall. Window types are single and paired 1/1 and 6/6 double-hung wood sash. The north elevation has a partial width, shed roof extension with scrolled metal supports. Two small additions have been removed from the north elevation. A concrete block shed is on the north side of the building.

The ca. 1953 building with no academic style at 4028 Parsons Drive is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4050 Parsons Drive (Parcel ID 18 334 01 090), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA
Year Built: circa 1953 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)
NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1950 building at 4050 Parsons Drive is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed with no academic style. It has an irregular-shaped plan (798 sq ft), vinyl exterior siding, and a built-up flat roof with wide overhanging eaves. The building's main entry is on the south elevation. Opposite the entrance, is a detached brick shed with a flat roof extension that continues over the walkway to above the entrance door. The east (street front) elevation has two window openings covered with plywood.

4068 Parsons Drive (Parcel ID 18 334 01 093), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1953 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1953 building at 4068 Parsons Drive is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed with no academic style. It has an irregular-shaped plan (948 sq ft), stucco exterior, and a built-up flat roof with wide overhanging eaves. The east (front) façade has central entrance that is covered with plywood. Opposite the entrance is a brick shed with a flat roof extension that continues over the walkway to above the entrance door. All window openings are covered with plywood.

The ca. 1953 building with no academic style at 4068 Parsons Drive is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4103 Parsons Drive (Parcel ID 18 334 01 121), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4103 Parsons Drive is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has a regular-shaped plan (840 sq ft) and a composition shingle cross-gable roof with no eaves, and a continuous concrete block foundation. The original exterior siding was removed, exposing plywood and vertical plank plywood. The west (front) façade has an off-center entrance, a single window opening, and a front-gabled-bay with two paired window groupings. All window openings are covered with plywood. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 building with no academic style at 4103 Parsons Drive is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4119 Parsons Drive (Parcel ID 18 334 01 133), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4119 Deacon Lane is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has an irregular rectangular plan (1,364 sq ft,) vinyl exterior siding, side-gabled roof with composition shingles, and a continuous concrete block foundation. Window openings feature 6/6 double-hung wood sash and a metal awning. The west (front) façade has an off-center entrance with an entry porch, a single window opening, and two paired window groupings. A shed roof addition is attached to the rear (east) elevation. A two-story, concrete block and wood frame garage with front-gabled roof is located at the end of the driveway.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4119 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4124 Parsons Drive (Parcel ID 18 334 01 126), Chamblee, DeKalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4124 Parsons Drive is a frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has an L-shaped plan (950 sq ft,) plywood exterior (exterior siding removed), side-gabled roof with composition shingles, and a continuous concrete foundation. All window openings are covered with plywood. The east (front) façade has an off-center entrance with an integrated front gable, concrete stoop, and paneled wood door. Two paired window groupings and a single window opening are on the east façade. The property has no associated outbuildings.

The ca. 1955 Minimal Traditional style building at 4124 Deacon Lane is a contributing resource to the Carver Hills historic district as it adds to the historical associations and historic architectural qualities for which the district is significant.

4124 Parsons Drive (Parcel ID 18 334 01 127), Chamblee, Dekalb County, GA

Year Built: circa 1955 (DeKalb County Property Appraiser)

NRHP Eligibility: Eligible (contributing to the Carver Hills historic district)

The ca. 1955 building at 4124 Parsons Drive is a wood frame, one-story, single-family residence constructed in the Minimal Traditional style. It has an L-shaped plan (990 sq ft,) vertical wood siding, side-gabled roof with composition shingles, and a continuous concrete block foundation. The four-bay-wide east (front façade) has an off-center entrance with paneled wood door, two paired window openings with shutters, a single window opening with shutters, and a partial uncovered concrete deck. All window openings have 1/1 double-hung wood sash. The property has no associated outbuildings.
