Our Toco Hill office lends the charm of bygone days to your business with Fulton Federal. Opened just last November, the Toco Hill office is our first branch in DeKalb County, and is temporarily operating in a gracious 95-year-old house that was originally the center of a 50-acre farm. (The permanent Toco Hill building is now under construction just east of the temporary quarters.) The property is situated directly across the street from Toco Hill Shopping Center at La Vista and North Druid Hills Roads. It was purchased in 1877 by George Hamilton Jones, who built the house soon thereafter. The house and part of the original parcel of land remained in the Jones family until it was purchased by Fulton Federal in 1972. Walter Hinson, Toco Hill manager, had as his guest for the Grand Opening Mrs. Dot Cash, who is the daughter of the late George Hamilton Jones and was born in the house in 1895. She recalled that the well still located in front of the house once supplied her family's drinking water, and that the grove of sweet gum trees that still surround the structure were planted by her father. 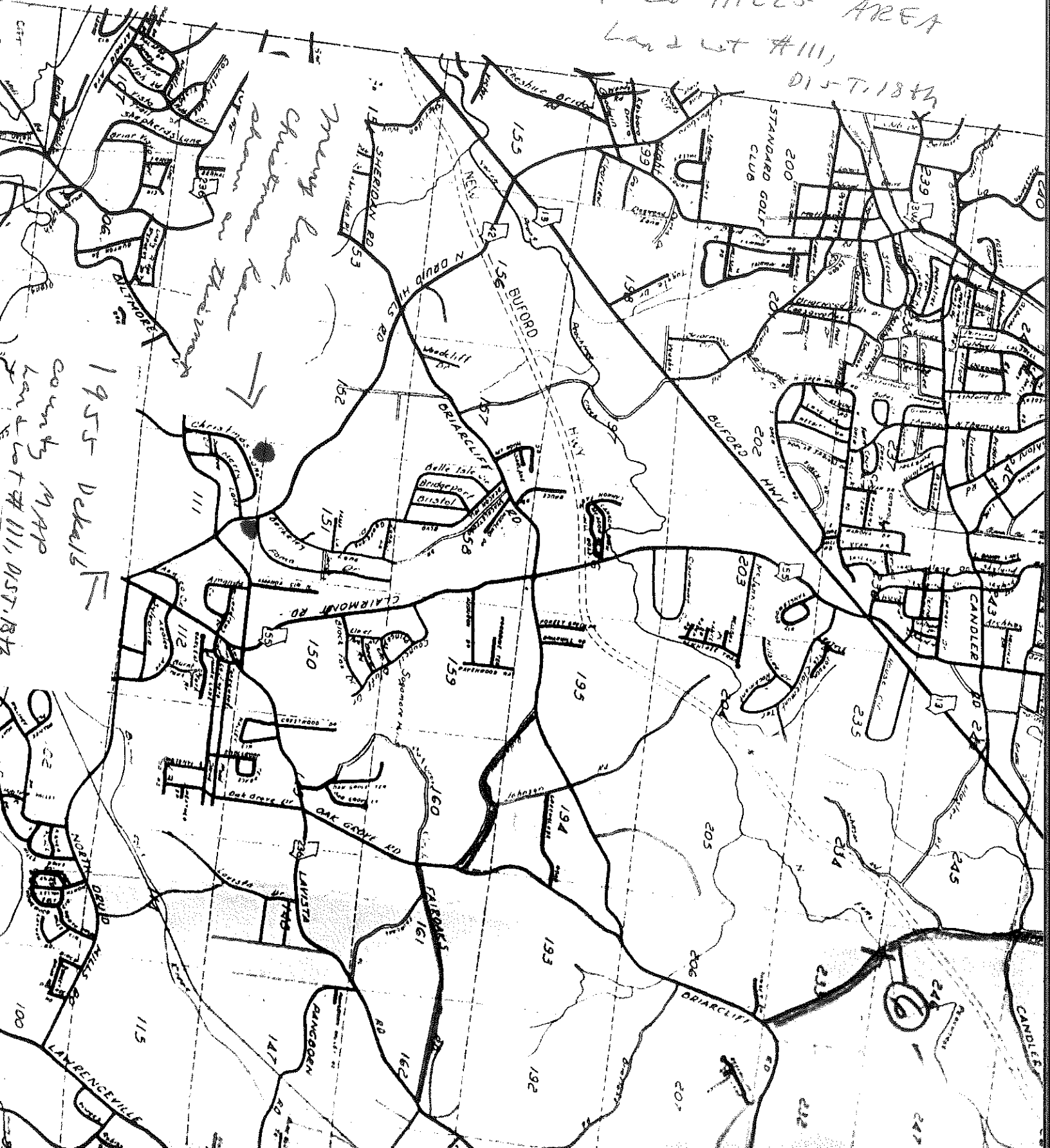
