After a bout with pneumonia and open heart surgery requiring five and one-half months of hospitalization, during which he was twice given up for dead, Dr. William G. Dr. Studer preached for 45 years without missing a Sunday in the pulpit. He has preached in 48 states and 16 foreign countries, authored 10 books, and conducted a weekly radio broadcast for 45 years.
