Over the years the church was rebuilt three times, once after being destroyed by fire. Mt. Moriah Baptist Church remained at 1600 Mt. Moriah Rd. in Atlanta, GA. for 117 years. On June 7, 1996, the church relocated to 1983 Brockett Rd. in Tucker, GA.

The first Minister of Mt. Moriah was Pastor Mason Harrison. The current Minister is Pastor Michael D. Woods.
