North of said Land Lot running South 100 feet thence east 210 feet thence North 100 feet, thence west 210 feet to starting point also another lot in part of Land Lot (376) three hundred & seventy-six commencing at the right away of the Roswell Railroad Co at the crossing of the original line of said land Lot & running along said right away 100 feet North thence East along a man's line 210 feet thence South 100 feet to original L.L. thence West 210 feet ~~thence South 100 feet to original L.L.~~ to starting point, containing one Acre more or less, reserving all rights of Simitary that belongs to said church property.

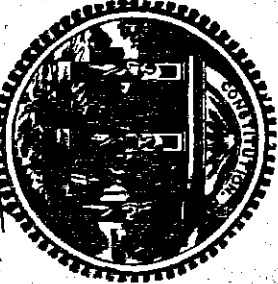

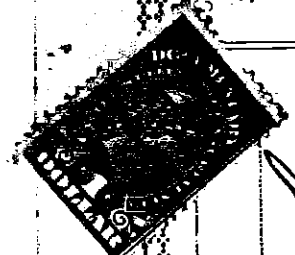
