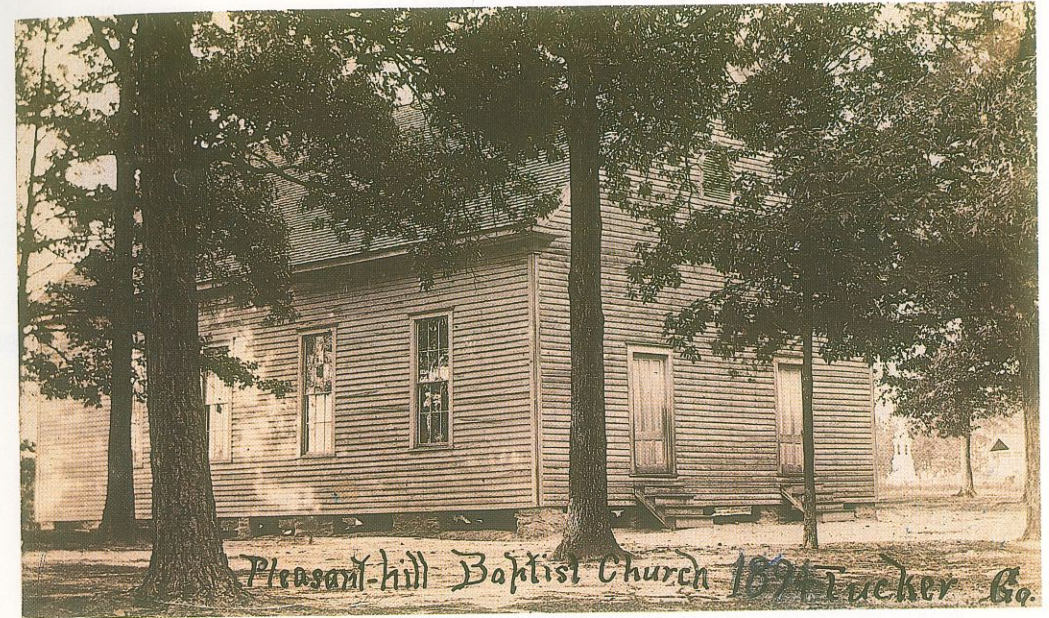

**CHURCH HISTORY**

Pleasant Hill started in a small log structure across the street from present location. 1.5 acres was purchased from W. D. Weaver for (\$15) on March 29, 1879. Other land purchases were; 1-7/8 acre (W. D. Weavers) for \$10 on 6/10/1896, 7/12 acre (Weaver family) for \$17.50 on 12/1/05, 4.31 acres (Minnie Britt) for \$430.00 on 4/25/28.

In 1922 fire destroyed all church records.

The present structure was started on 03/10/49. 01/30/70 addition Sunday School were added on. A Fellowship Hall was added on 07/04/86.

THE RULES OF DECORUM OF  
PLEASANT HILL BAPTIST CHURCH

TUCKER, GEORGIA

1. Church membership shall be composed of members of same faith and order.
2. Church worship shall begin with divine worship.
3. The church shall have a clerk who shall keep a fair and full record of all her proceedings and sign her orders.
4. The pastor of church shall uniformly preside as moderator when present and in his absence the church shall choose an ordained minister or deacon that is a member of this church and is in full fellowship to act as moderator.
5. At the opening of conference it shall be the duty of the Moderator to invite visiting members to sit with us and assist in business if called upon.
6. The foregoing rules and business shall be taken up in the following order.
  - (a) The moderator shall open the doors of church for reception of members.
  - (b) Then call for reference as they stand in order, then all business necessary to come before the conference.
  - (c) No motion shall be attended to without a second and when any member is going to speak in conference he shall rise and address the Moderator in a mild Christian manner and shall not depart from the subject.
  - (d) If any member speaks in a manner which transgresses the rules of the church, the Moderator shall call him to order, but the member called to order shall have the right of the voice of the church.
  - (e) It shall be the duty of each male member to attend each conference, and any failing to shall at the next regular conference give his reason for absence and any member that has missed three successive conferences is due the church acknowledgments.
  - (f) If any member shall be guilty of gossiping or carrying injurious tales from one to another in a hurtful manner, speaking evil of each other in their absence or to their face shall be deemed guilty of unchristian conduct and dealt with accordingly.
  - (g) In the transaction of any business that shall come before the conference a majority in all cases shall rule excepting cases pertaining to fellowship, then it shall be unanimous, any dissenting vote shall give a Scriptural reason.
  - (h) Any of the foregoing rules may be altered, amended or added to by two-thirds of members present at any regular conference.
  - (i) If any member violates any known rules it shall be their duty to give reason for such conduct and in their failure to do so it shall be the duty of the church to inquire in such cases.
  - (j) It shall be the duty of the clerk to read the rules of decorum annually or semi-annually as the church may require.
  - (k) When any member is holding an office of the church and new officers have been elected it shall be their duty to turn all belongings of the church over to the new officers.
  - (l) It shall be the duty of any member to be excused by the Moderator before leaving while in conference.
  - (m) It shall be the duty of the church to commune at each May and August meeting.
  - (n) It shall be the duty of the church to observe foot washing at each annual August meeting, each taking such part or parts as their conscience may dictate.
  - (o) All church officers and pastor shall be elected by the conference before the first Sunday in September of each year. In case of death or any other event, the church shall call a conference to fill the vacancy.

## THE YELLOW RIVER BAPTIST ASSOCIATION

By John D. Humphries

### I

The Yellow River Baptist Association was constituted at Harris's Spring Church, in Newton County, Saturday, September 18, 1824. The minutes recite:

"The committee appointed by the Sarepta and Ocmulgee Associations, consisting of the brethren Isham Goss, Reuben Thornton, Edmund Talbott, James Brooks, Iveson L. Brooks, Richard Pace, and Cyrus White, convened at Harris's Spring, Newton County, on the 18th of September, 1824; when,

"An introductory sermon was delivered by John Landers, from John 16th Ch. and part of the 7th verse; then repaired to the house, and finding thirteen churches in regular order, assisted in forming them into an Association, which was done on the following principles, to-wit:

"We, the churches of Jesus Christ, who have been regularly baptised upon a profession of our faith, are convinced from a series of experiences of the necessity of a combination of churches, and of maintaining a correspondence for the preserving of a federal union amongst all the churches of the same faith and order.

"And as we are convinced that there are a number of Baptist churches who differ from us in faith and practice, and that it is impossible to have communion where there is no union, we think it our duty to set forth a concise declaration of the faith and order upon which we intend to associate; which is as follows:

"1. We believe in one only true and living God; and that there is a trinity of persons in the Godhead - the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost; and yet there are not three Gods, but one God.

"2. We believe that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament are the words of God, and the only rule of faith and practice.

"3. In the fall of Adam and the imputation of his sin to his posterity. In the corruption of human nature, and the impotency of man to recover himself by his own free will and ability.

"4. In the everlasting love of God to his people and the eternal election of a definite number of the human race, to grace and glory; and that there was a covenant of grace, or redemption made between the Father and the Son before the world began, in which their salvation is secure, and that they in particular are redeemed.

"5. That sinners are justified in the sight of God, only by the righteousness of Christ imputed to them.

"6. That all those who were chosen in Christ will be effectually called, regenerated, converted, sanctified, and supported by the spirit and power of God, so that they shall persevere in grace, and not one of them be finally lost.

In 1842, Mountain Creek church in DeKalb County, was attached to the Fourth District, according to her request, giving the Association 41 churches and 1474 members.

Pleasant Hill, in DeKalb County, "formerly withdrawn from this body for holding a disorderly member in her body", petitioned for restoration, and was received "on her acknowledgement". (Abs. from 154)

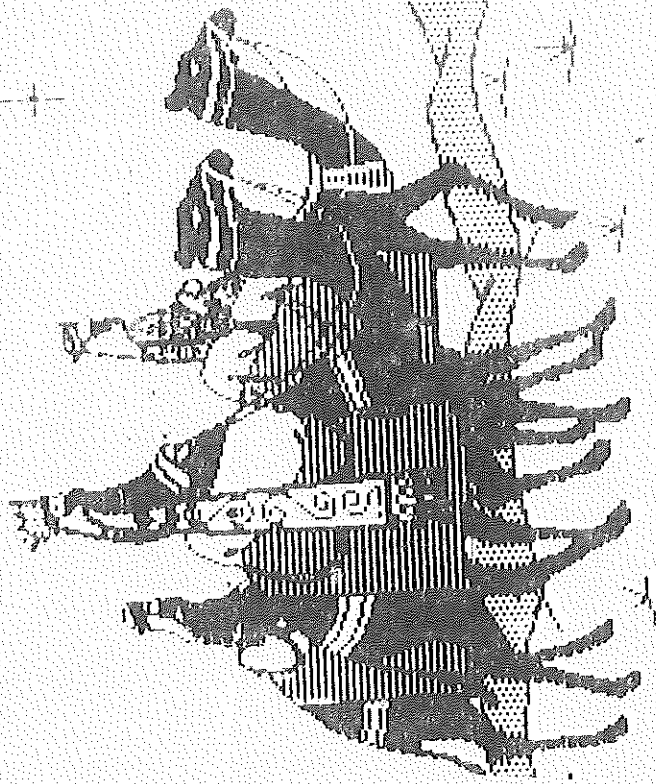
