The Ray of Hope Christian Church is celebrating black history, inspired by the theme, "Black by God's Design: A Masterpiece."

The observance, which began Jan. 21, will continue through March 3 with weekly sermons durand

ing Sunday worship service and Friday seminars. On each Friday in February at 7 p.m. a different seminar will be given.

In the upcoming weeks, emphasis will be placed on the educational, occupational, recreational/creative, and spiritual aspects of the black experience. In addition to sermons on these topics, dramatic readings, poems, biographical sketches and articles by some of God's black "masterpieces" from history will be presented

The Friday seminars will allow members and guests to explore in depth some of the key elements of being black in America. The first Friday seminar addressed "Our History and Heritage," through film, pantomime, oral presentation, audience participation, and panel discussions. The Feb. 9 seminar will address "Threats to Our Heritage." Major issues that prevent black Americans from fulfilling their potential such as substance and other celf-defeat. stance abuse, and other self-defeating behaviors will be presented


