The Assessment for Presiding Elder and Pastor is divided among the churches, as follows: Redan, \$275.00; Rock Chapel, \$250.00; Wesley Chapel, \$215.00, and Belmont, \$150.00, which in terms of percentage is, as follows: Redan, 30.9; Rock Chapel, 28.1; Wesley Chapel, 24.2, and Belmont, 16.8. This is the basis of the apportionment of the benevolences to the respective churches. Redan, \$162.00; Rock Chapel, \$147.00; Wesley Chapel, \$127.00; Belmont, \$89.00.

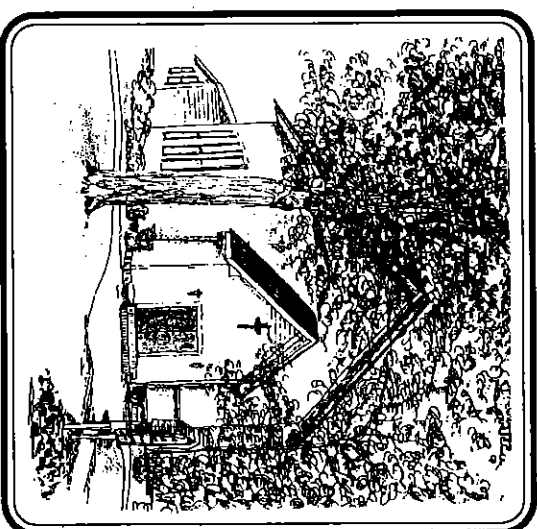

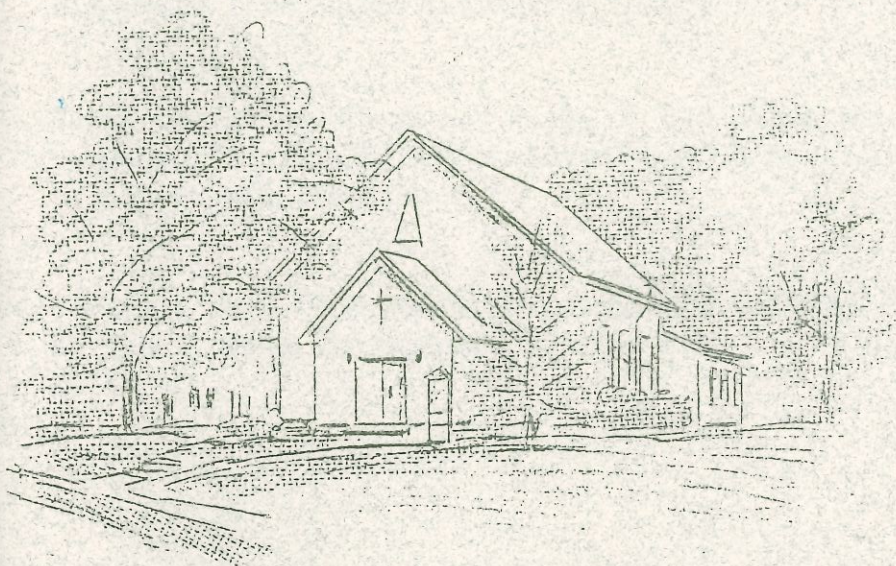

The Introduction—

In celebration of this special anniversary of Redan United Methodist Church, the Centennial Committee is pleased to present the first issue of "Centennial Notes." These notes are about how long ago one hundred years can be and how not so long ago one hundred years can be. They are about beginnings and endings, greetings and farewells, simplicity and wisdom, enthusiasm and continuity. They are familiar, but rarely intimate. They are historical, but not history.

The goal of the notes, if there is one, is to provide an impression of the church's past from what has survived to leave an impression. The notes are to be of interest and entertaining, but they are often distant and unfocused. Indeed, The Editor promises the distant and unfocused past because it is distant and unfocused, and because it probably won't get The Editor into trouble.
