Description: The Hamilton Family records contain such items as an autograph book from the 1870s with many entries to Miss Jones, and addressing her as teacher. E.H. Hamilton was a minister in the Presbyterian Church, or perhaps a missionary and there are materials relating to his time in Taiwan, life insurance papers for Evelyn Harrison Hamilton, tithing records and vaccination records for Mrs. L.O. Huggins and Susie Hamilton. There is a fragile scrapbook full of poems from the late 1800s and Presbyterian mission materials. There is also the bible of E.H. Hamilton. *It is unclear at this time if E.H. is Evelyn*.
