Biography of Judge Clarence F Seeliger: Clarence Seeliger is from Seattle, Washington. He moved to Atlanta to attend Emory Law School in the 1960s. He is a veteran. He worked for Maynard Jackson's U.S. Senate campaign as well as a defense attorney. He also worked for Governor Jimmy Carter's commission related to Vietnam Veterans. He defeated Judge Oscar Mitchell in the 1980 DeKalb County State Court judge campaign. He would be elected many more times as DeKalb County Superior Court judge until retiring in December 2020.

Description: The Judge Clarence Seeliger collections contains mostly correspondence, both personal and court related. It also contains court papers, photos, awards, newspaper articles, DVDs, and other ephemera. Items were donated in storage boxes with titles on most boxes- items were moved to archival boxes and box titles were retained (Original Order).
