Organizational History of Clifton Academy: The papers here show that the school opened on the first Monday in January of 1859. The articles between the patrons of the school and a John M. Huey are included in this collection.

Description: The Clifton Academy Collection contains documents relating to Clifton Academy, including 11 months of daily attendance records, yearly attendance for 1858, five sets of laws and rules for the school, and miscellaneous papers included with the records. Teacher/principal surnames includes Huey and Wells.
