Biographical Sketch of Tim Jones: Jones moved to DeKalb in 1950 and operated Tim Jones' Cleaners and Laundry at 1900 Candler Road. He studied civil engineering at the University of Florida and was on active duty with the Army from 1943 to 1947. He held the Legion of Merit for 25 years; membership in the Kiwanis International.

Description: Tim Jones was the DeKalb County complaint man, as well as Chief Dogcatcher Emeritus. His papers contain clippings from the newspaper naming him the complaint man, letters regarding his estate after his death, Christmas cards, and genealogy information. There is a certificate included that makes Abram Jones a Captain in the Reserve Corps in 1952, and a certificate of his honorable discharge in 1953. Jones also served as the director of the DeKalb animal control unit.
