Description: Percy Ligon's papers include dress designs and sketches by Susie York. There are postcards addressed to Percy Ligon, a Navy Rating Description for James D. York, and several news clippings on the school for the deaf in Atlanta, as well as the Nadfrat Woman's Club, an organization for the deaf and mute. Nadfrat is a derivation of the NAD, National Association of the Deaf and the "Frats," National Fraternal Society of the Deaf. Percy Ligon's press club pass from 1936 is also included.
