Newspaper Books Collection

Introduction: This collection of historic DeKalb County newspapers includes newspapers from 1919-1995. Not every year of every newspaper within that span is represented in the collection. Primary titles include the *DeKalb New Era*, the *Decatur-DeKalb News*, and the *Decatur-DeKalb News/Era*.

Provenance: Collection is made up of multiple accessions and donations.

DeKalb New Era, Decatur-DeKalb News/Era, and Decatur-DeKalb News/Era Business and Financial Review newspapers were donated by Joe Hiett of DeKalb News: accession #1998.24; accession date April 30, 1998.

Access: Access to the collection requires advanced notice because of the large format books. Single photocopies may be made for research purposes. Permission to publish materials from this collection must be requested from the Archivist.

Size: 176 bound volumes, broadsheet and tabloid size. *DeKalb New Era* measures approximately 22.75" by 17.75", *Decatur-DeKalb News/Era* measures approximately 23.5" by 14.5", and the *Decatur-DeKalb News/Era Business and Financial Review* measures approximately 14" by 11.5".

Description: This collection of historic DeKalb County newspapers includes newspapers from 1919-1995. Not every year of every newspaper within that span is represented in the collection. In particular, the collection of bound issues of the DeKalb New Era from years prior to 1940 is incomplete. While physical copies of papers from these years are not available, the microfilm collection in the archives includes images of the New Era from 1911-1955, filling in the gaps in the bound newspaper collection.

An odd doubling takes place within the collection of books of the Decatur-DeKalb News in the early 1970's. Two different editions of the News seem to have been produced – one with the masthead reading "The Decatur-DeKalb News North" that appeared on Wednesdays and one simply called "The Decatur DeKalb News" that appeared on Thursdays. The News North is bound by year and the News is bound in six month segments. The News North seems to appear in years prior to 1973, while the News covers years following 1973. The collection includes bound copies of both publications in 1973.

Near the end of 1978, the owners of the Decatur-DeKalb News bought the DeKalb New Era. The first edition of the merged Decatur-DeKalb News/Era appeared on January 4, 1979. This purchase is noted in the first issue of the 1979 Decatur-DeKalb News Business and Financial Review.

Though the collection ends in 1995, there are implications that the DeKalb News/Era continued on at least into 1996. The final issue of the News/Era in the collection previews the newspaper's planned coverage of the then approaching 1996 Olympics.
