Notes given by a researcher as recorded by Frances Overcash, Archivist – October 2001

*On the 1850 census:*

J.T. Akridge is John Thomas Akridge

Martha who is listed on the census as 2 years old is actually around 19-20 years old. Martha was J.T. Akridge's wife. Martha is listed on the 1860 census as 29 years old.

George W. should be listed as 11 years old rather than 1 year old.

Martha Rainey may be Martha Akridge's mother.

*On the 1860 census:*

J.T. Akridge and family are listed as living in Fulton County. His family is listed as:

Martha, wife, age 29

Mary C., daughter, age 7

Jesse R, son, age 4

William T., son, age 3 months
