The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, that if the above bound

W. W. Hammett administrator of the Goods, Chattels and Credits of B. H. Hammett deceased, to make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said W. W. Hammett

or in the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him and the same so made to exhibit in the Court of Ordinary of said County when he shall be therunto required, and such goods, chattels and credits, do well and truly administer according to law, and to make a just and true account of his actings and doings therein when required by the Superior Court or the Ordinary for said County, and all the rest of the goods, chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon the account of the administration, the same being first allowed by the said court, shall deliver and pay to such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by law.
