Witnesseth: That the said Mayor and Council of the City of Decatur, for and in consideration of the sum of Five and 10/10 Dollars to them in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said

Dr. J. H. Green his heirs and assigns, Cemetery Lots Nos. 39 & 40 in ~~the new cemetery platted by Gen. M. Haunsteen~~ ^{in the new cemetery as surveyed and platted by Charles Pratt, Civil En-} gineer) in Land Lot No _____ of the District of originally Henry, now DeKalb County, Georgia.

To have and to hold the said Lot, unto him, the said Dr. J. H. Green his heirs and assigns, for the purpose of sepulture forever, in fee simple.

And the said Mayor and Council of the City of Decatur, for themselves, and for their successors in office, the said lots Nos. 39 & 40 unto the said

Dr. J. H. Green will warrant and forever defend the right and title thereof against themselves and against all other persons whomsoever.
