The petition of Joseph Walker Showeth that Nancy Eskew of said county is an Ediot and therefore incable of managing her affairs; that said Nancy Eskew has a large real and personal Estate with some dollars wasting as will be dailly; and that said Nancy is an Idiot and incapable of taking care of herself and estate that she may come to want, unless she and her property are taken care of for which cause he prays this Court to appoint suitable persons, commissioners, to investigate the matter according to law and if the charge of your petitioner is sanctioned to have a guardian appointed for said Nancy Eskew .
