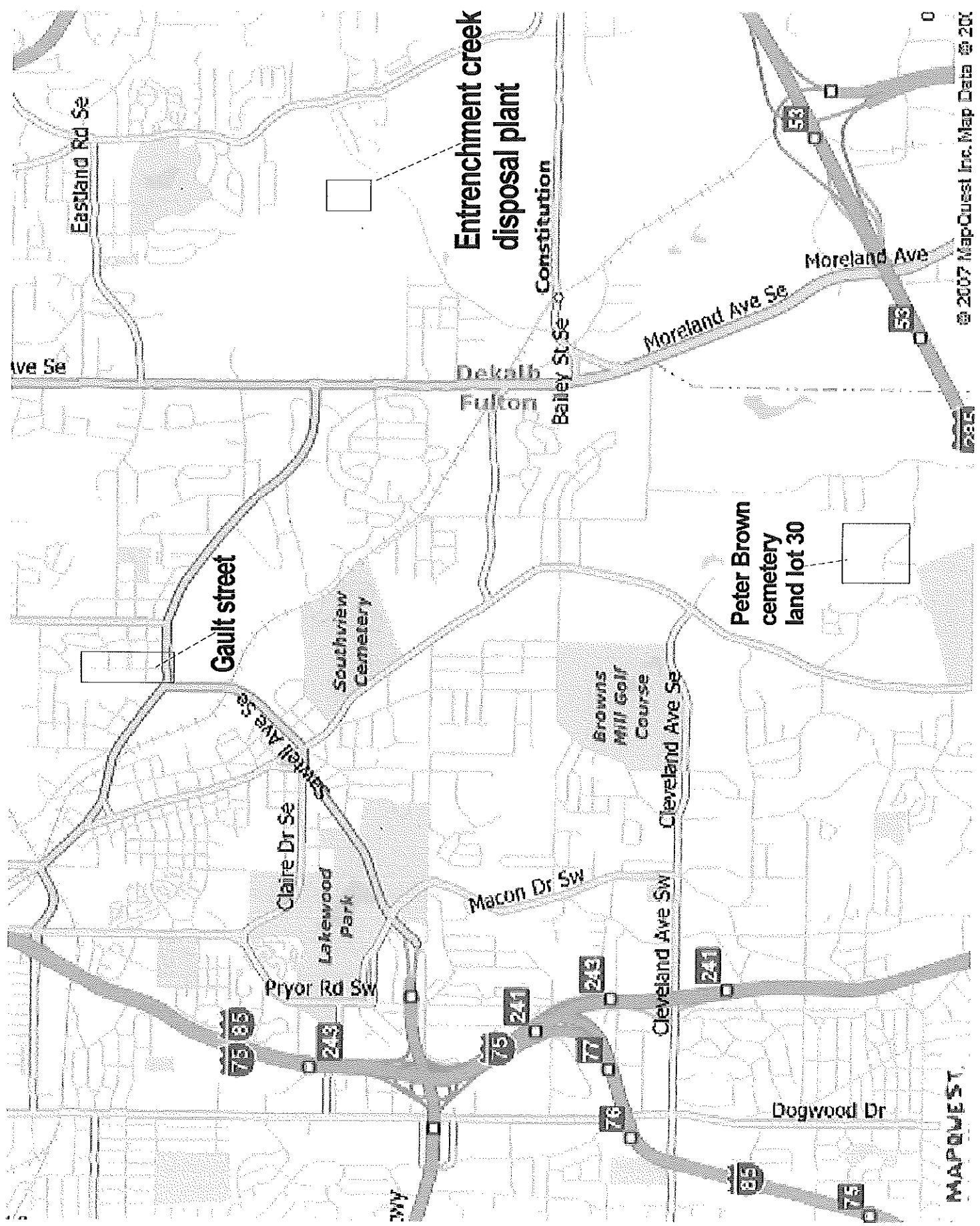

The Atlanta Historical Bulletin Vol. XI, Dec. 1966 No. 4  
 De Kalb County lost two good citizens, both named Brown, to the grim reaper in 1840. First to go, on January 9, was Peter brown, one of the original settlers in what is now the South Bend District of Fulton County. He was born in 1778 and carne to DeKalb from Franklin County in the winter of 1822-1823. A farmer and blacksmith, he built the first sawmill on Entrenchment Creek upon the present site of the city sewage disposal plant on that stream. Mr. Brown was the father of Killis. Meredith, William T., Joel and Edgefield Brown, all useful citizens of the Atlanta area in their day. Peter Brown is buried in his family cemetery in South Bend District.

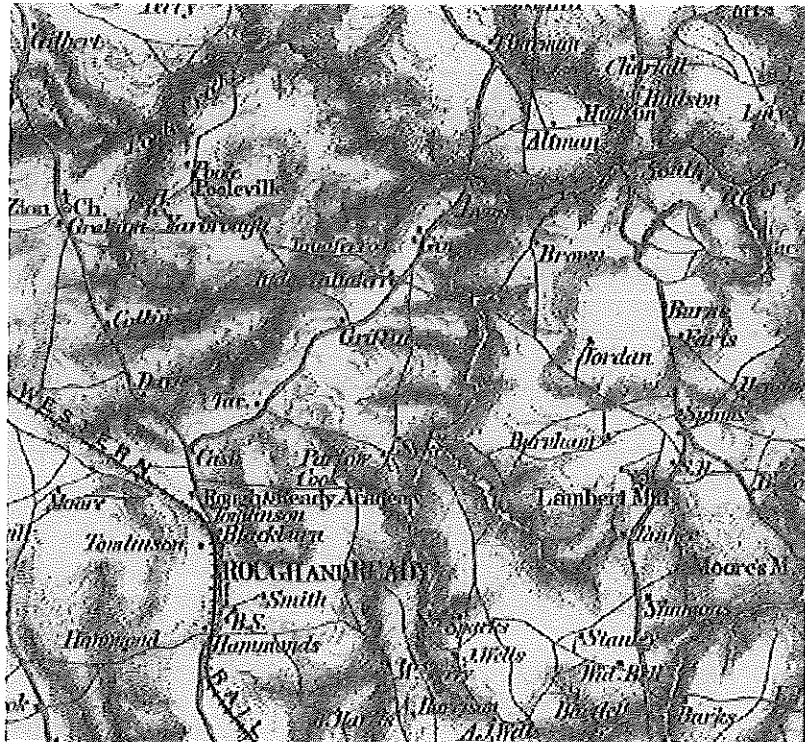
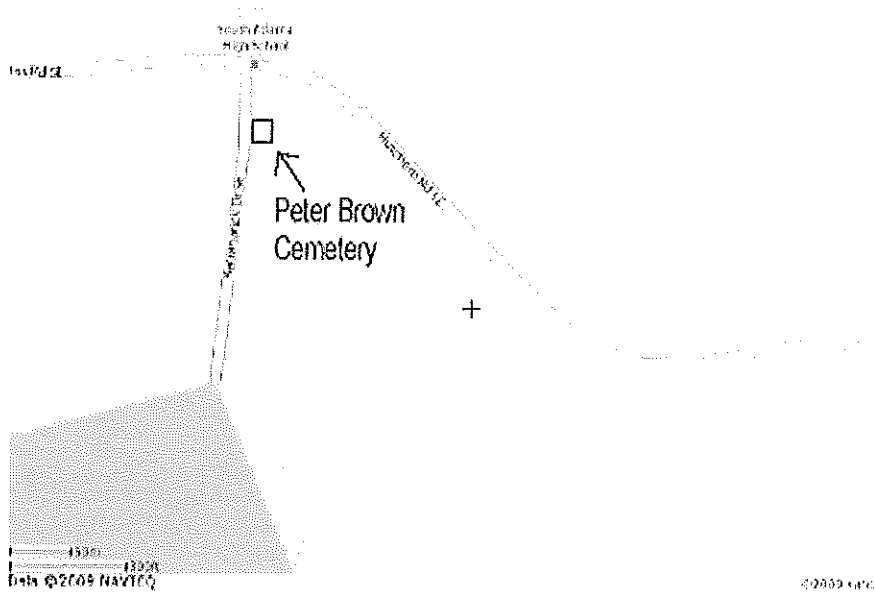
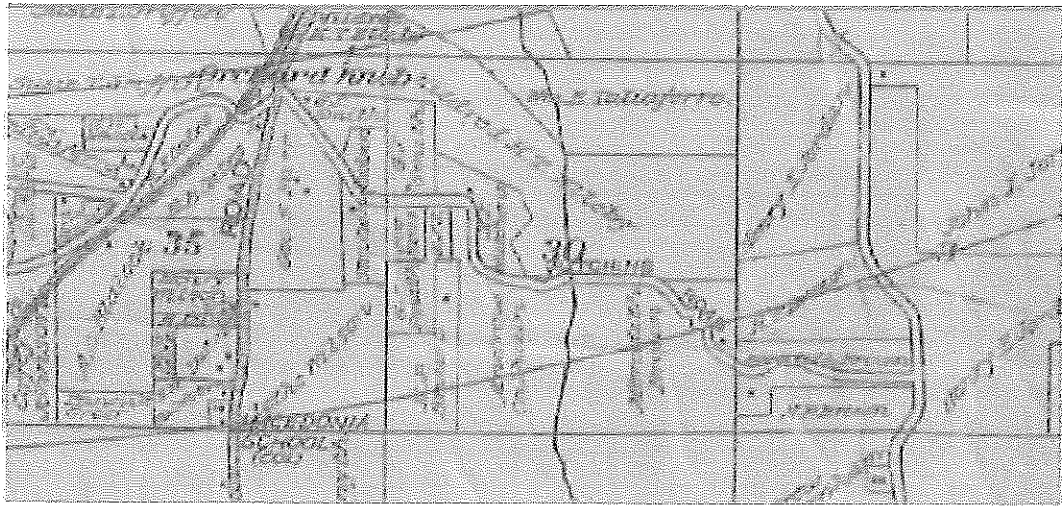

DEED dated  Jan  rec. from JOHN BROWN of Ga. To his well beloved son PETER BROWN. Conveys 80 ac. On waters of Shoal Crk., being part of 200 ac. Granted to JAMES McCee (?) 31 Jan. 1791. Wit: JOHN TABOR, BENJAMIN (?) KING, J.P. (NOTE  this page was partially covered over when microfilmed).

DEED BOOK OO

DEED OF GIFT dated Ga. 22 April 1802, rec. 24 April 1803, from JOHN BROWN of Franklin Co. to his son PETER BROWN of same. For love, etc., conveys 150 ac. In Franklin Co., on waters of Shoal Crk., adj. the Academy land, Shields, and Merideth Brown. Wit: James Chandler, Elizabeth Chandler. Sworn to by James Chandler before Henry Chaplear, J.I.C. 24 April 1802.

AFFIDAVIT dated Franklin Co. 14 Sept. 1799, rec. 17 Sept. 1799, of MOSES PAYNE, stating that on 17 Aug. "last past" there was a "combat" between MOSES PAYNE and PETER BROWN at the house of CHARLES BOND, at which time said BROWN lost a part of one ear. MOSES PAYNE requests same be admitted to record. Wit: HEZ'H TERRELL.

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### Killis Brown

Buried at New Hope Methodist Church Cemetery, DeKalb County, GA (near Atlanta Penitentiary). Church founded 1869; burned 1936. Location on Moreland Avenue, SE, about two miles south of the Penitentiary.

Shown in 1850 DeKalb Co, GA, census with 8 children.

Atlanta Historical Society Bulletin Vol XII, June, 1967, No. 2 quote: "The plantation of Killis Brown was in the vicinity of the present Southern Railway station known as Constitution.

The Chattahoochee Brick Company bought Brown property located on the South River in DeKalb Co, GA.

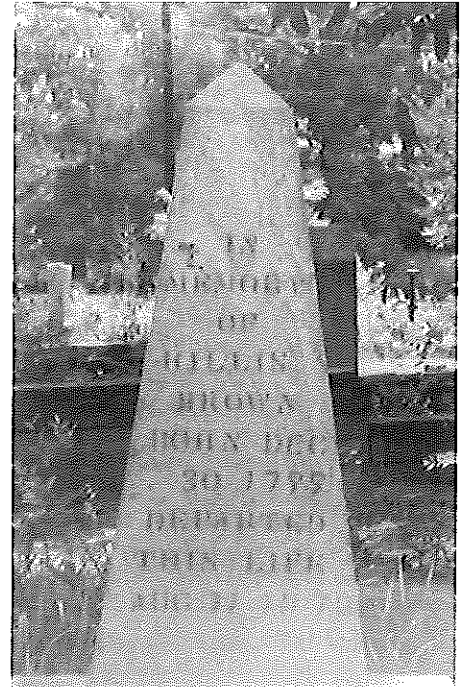
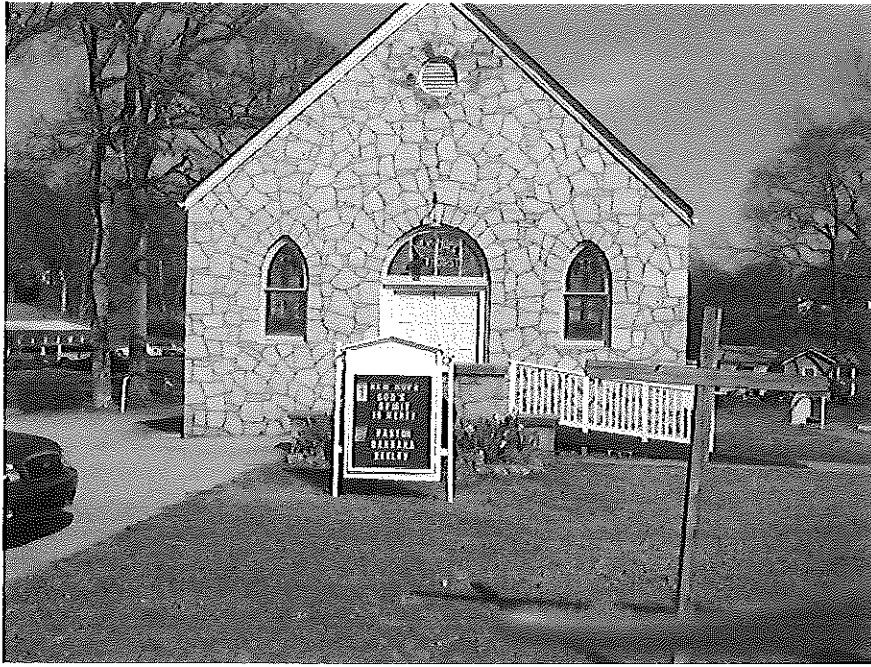
