Juhan, Administrator of Richard Holt, deceased, applied to this Court for leave to hire out the negroes belonging to said estate untill the first Tuesday in February next (1863) privately or publicly and they the said J.W. Scruggs and N.S. Juhan, Administrators, believing it to be for the best interest of said estate and no injustice done to the heirs and creditors of said estate. It is therefore ordered by the Court that said Administrators be permitted by the Court to hire out the negroes untill the first Tuesday in February next (1863) publicly or privately as they may deem best, and to the interest of all concerned.
