I Generation

Feb. 15, 1983

JOHN LAVELLE (1675-1740). Came to America as French Huguenot about 1715, or before. Settled in Virginia. Compendium Vol. 1, p. 681, Virginia - probably in York County.

II Generation

Robert Leavell (1718-1797) Born in Virginia. Wife Sarah Coles. In 1769 left Virginia and was given land grant by King George III at Newberry County, South Carolina. Deacon in Bush River Baptist Church. Five children Possible Colonial service. Buried in Bush River Baptist Cemetery in Newberry County, South Carolina.

III Generation

Edward Leavell, Born July 16, 1756(57?) in South Carolina. Married Rachel Williams (second wife) April 26, 1795. Died January 16, 1832 in Dekalb Co. GA. Believed to be buried in the Old Fellowship Cemetery in Tucker, GA. In CANDLER CENTENNIAL SPEECH, by Charles Murphey Candler, Nov. 9, 1822, in Dekalb County, Ga. Candler stated Edward Leavell was among 6 Revolutionary War Soldiers who became Dekalb citizens and are buried here. (Heritage of Dekalb, DECATUR/DEKALB NEWS, July 23, 1981, page 7G) Listed on Franklin Co. Land and Tax Records 1801-1806. (May have received a Land Grant in Franklin Co.) Members of Old Fellowship Pr. Bapt. Ch. Tucker, GA., in 1833.

IV Generation

Tucker, GA., in 1833.

John W. Leavell. Born Nov 4, 1804, in South Carolina. Married Mary C. Wood, January 16, 1825. Died April 5, 1865, in Dekalb County GA. Buried in the Gresham-Weed Cemetery, Tucker-Chamblee Rd., Dekalb Co. (Wife's marker reads: Polly C. Leavell, Jan., 1804 - Sept. 15, 1892) (Also, Franklin Leavell, Feb. 14, 1812 - June 30, 1864) 1850 Dekalb Co. Federal Census Records, Browning's Dist., show only one Leavell family; John W. Level, his wife Mary and 14 members of his household; John C. age 24; James R. (Riley?) Nancy E. age 21 (m. Wm. C. Gresham?); Rachel E., 19; Wm. J. (Joseph?)(m. Pegg Russell Gresham?); Richard N., 3; Francis M., 16; Edward F. (Frank?) 14; Mary E. 13; Geo. W., 11; Susan A., 9; Laura, 7, (m. Josiah A. Gresham, son of Silas W. G.); Andrew J. or T? 5; Richard H. 3 John W. Leavell's name appears on the Georgia Poor School and Academy List for Dekalb County, no date - somewhere 1826 and 1853 or 1854. 1860 Census of Dekalb County, Browning Dist. also lists John W. Leavell, age 55, and wife Polly C. age 56. Children: Rachel A., Susan A., Laura A., A. J., Richard H., George W., and two grandchildren? (believed to be children of James Riley Leavell and his first wife Sara Reeves) Polly A., age 8, and John W. age 4, born in Arkansas. Land Records of Dekalb Co., Dist 18, show John W. Leavell owned land in Land Lot #287, 65 Acres, an additional 6 Acres in this same Land lot, and 30 Acres in Land Lot #292, 18 Dist.

V GENERATION

Frank Leavell, b. ca 1836 m. Amanda Jane Walker. Died Mar 30, 1900, in Draketown, GA, Haralson County (near Temple, GA) is buried in Draketown Bapt. Ch. Cem. (Walker Family Lot). They lived in Paulding Co., GA. and in Cullman Co, Alabama, where Amanda died Sept. 29, 1884 (Near Sand Mountain). They had three children: Jack Leavell m. Mary Crow, Cullman, Ala.; Mary (Molly) Leavell, never married, died in Dekalb Co. Feb. 1940 and Sarah Eveline Leavell b. Oct 30, 1877 & Laura Cox m. Elmer Leonard Cash. Paulding Co. Ga.

VI Generation

SARAH EVELINE LEAVELL, b. Oct 30, 1877, Paulding Co. GA., married Elmer Leonard Cash, son of Oliver Perry Cash and Amanda Jane Cash. Lived in Dekalb Co, members of Rehoboth Baptist Church, Tucker, GA., Buried Rehoboth Cem. Sarah died Aug. 13, 1953. Elmer died July 3 1944. (he was born July 3 1875). He was a farmer. They had eight daughters: Amanda Missouri (Pylant) b. Apr 24, 1894; Eula, 1896; Nettie Lee Cash, Mar 19 1903; Cora Belle (Henderson) Jan. 7, 1905; Ida Irene (Holeman), Nov 30 1906; Winnie Viola (Haralson) Nov. 24, 1908, Evie Estelle, 1910; Sarah Gertrude (Mitchell) Oct. 17, 1913.

AMANDA MISSOURI CASH, (daughter of SARAH EVELINE LEAVELL,) b. April 24, 1894, married Lonnie Lyman Pylant (May 17, 1886- Apr. 20, 1923) m. Oct. 1, 1911. Lived in Dekalb Co. Ga. They had one daughter Bertha Mae Pylant (Gresham) b. Dec. 26, 1912. Missouri's second husband was Joseph Brown Haralson (Nov. 20, 1874 -Apr. 14, 1955), m. 1934, they had one daughter: Mary Ruth Haralson (Quinn). Mem. Midway Bapt. Church.

VIII Generation

BERTHA MAE PYLANT (granddaughter of SARAH EVELINE LEAVELL) b. Dec. 26, 1912. Married James Otis Gresham (Feb. 4, 1910 - Mar. 17, 1975) lived in Dekalb Co. Members Midway Baptist Church, Tucker, GA. They had two children: James Billy Gresham, May 28, 1932 - Sept. 23, 1982; and Mary Grace Gresham (Flowers) b. Jun. 15, 1934 (Otis Gresham and Billy Gresham buried in Gresham/Weed Cemetery, Dekalb Co. GA.

IX Generation

MARY GRACE GRESHAM (Great-granddaughter of SARAH EVELINE LEAVELL) b. June 15, 1934. Married Fred Allen Flowers (Aug. 1, 1930) m. July 5, 1952 (Evans Co.) Lived in Dekalb and Gwinnett Co. GA. Three sons: Fred Allen Flowers, Aug. 4, 1954, Twins: Robert Keith and Donald Lamar Flowers, Sept. 11, 1958. Members of Lilburn First Baptist Church, Lilburn, GA.
