Biographical Sketch

Clarence R. Vaughn, Jr. was born in Conyers, Rockdale County, Georgia, on January 22, 1921. His mother was the former Mary Julia Guinn and his father the late Judge Vaughn of the Stone Mountain Judicial Circuit.

He is married to the former Doris Henson and has two sons, Alvin H. Vaughn, Age 20 and C. Roland Vaughn, Age 19.

He and his family live on a farm in Rockdale County, Georgia, where he raises Charolais Cattle and Orchids.

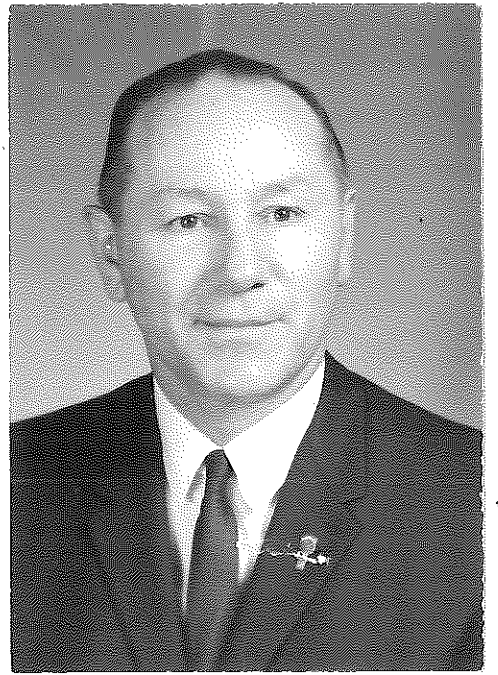
Mr. Vaughn was educated in the public schools of Rockdale County, graduated from North Georgia Junior College and received his L. L. B. Degree in Law from the University of Georgia. He served in the Armed Forces of the United States from 1942 until 1945, twenty-six months of which was overseas duty in the European Theater of operations. Since his discharge he has been a practicing Attorney in Rockdale County and DeKalb County, and is Attorney for the City of Conyers and Rockdale County.

He served ten years in the General Assembly of Georgia, having served two years in the Senate and now serving his eighth year in the House of Representatives. During the last Session of the General Assembly he served as Chairman of the Highway Committee, member of the Appropriations Committee and member of the Rules Committee, three of the most important committees of the House.

During prior Sessions he has served as member of Reapportionment Study Committee, Vice-Chairman of Special Judiciary Committee, member of Ways and Means and during each year of service has been a member of the powerful Rules Committee.

Mr. Vaughn is a member of the First Methodist Church of Conyers, serving on the Official Board and as Superintendent of the Church School, and is a Trustee of Salem Campground. He is a Director of the Bank of Rockdale, a Mason, member of the Lions Club, Rotary Club, V. F. W., American Legion, and serves as a member of the Hospital Board of Rockdale County Hospital.

Mr. Vaughn is presently serving as Representative of the 117th District Post No. 1, composed of part of DeKalb County and all of Rockdale County. He is unopposed for re-election to serve for the 1969-70 Session of the General Assembly and his new District due to Reapportionment is the 74th District composed partly of DeKalb and all of Rockdale County.



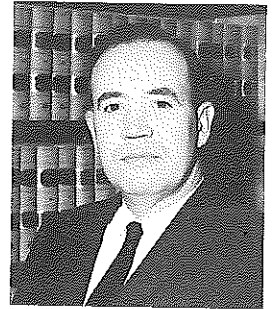
