

NESBIT FAMILY CEMETERY

Located at the corner of Highway 29 (Lawrenceville Hwy.) & Jimmy Carter/Mountain Industrial Blvd.
It is across from the Target Store and behind the Georgia Power building.

The cemetery is a small family plot that is a little overgrown and some of the graves have been desecrated. The oldest grave is of Mary Nesbit born Nov. 2, 1789 and died Jan. 3, 1849.

As you enter the cemetery a descendant has erected a plastic sign with the following:

William Nesbit 1789 0 1863
Veteran of War of 1812

Widen of an Indian trail in 1811, He supervised the building of a military road from Fort Daniel to a Shallow Ford on the Chattahoochee River. This is now Peachtree Road.

About 1815, meeting at the Wynn House at Hog Mountain he and others began the creation of Gwinnett County and was appointed first sheriff and was elected the second and fourth term as state legislator, he represented Gwinnett County, at Milledgeville, from 1829 to 1831.

On this site located his plantation of 650 acres.
