The Permanent Secretary of the State Democratic Executive Committee, who is also Permanent Secretary of the Special Democratic Primary Subcommittee, which consists of eight members, stated to Mr. Lowe on afternoon of April 28 that Mr. Lowe's name, as candidate for Representative for 130th District in Fulton County, will definitely be on the ballot for the May 5th Democratic Primary. Mr. Lowe paid the required \$500.00 fee and filed required Declaration of Candidacy on April 19th, last day for entries. Within the next two days some supporters of his political opponents brought pressure on some members of the eight-member Democratic Sub-Committee to disqualify him as a candidate on their pretense that he did not meet residence requirement. He does meet residence requirement, as prescribed by applicable law, to be such a candidate for representative for the 130th District in the May 5th Democratic Primary.

#### BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

EDUCATION: Student at Mercer University for two years-later became student at Emory University and received B.Ph. and A.M. degrees there, more than a year of postgraduate study there leading to A.M. degree having been mainly in Government-passed Georgia State Bar Examination in 1947 after having studied law about two years in night law colleges in Atlanta-received LL.M. degree from Woodrow Wilson College of Law in 1952-total of 8-1/2 years of college training. OTHER DATA, INCLUDING EXPERIENCE: Has practiced law in Atlanta 17 years-high school or college teacher for 10 years before then, including two years, 1946-48, teaching Government and History in Georgia State College in Atlanta-volunteered and served 5-1/2 years on active Army duty in World War II-active member of Officers Reserve Corps or Army Reserve for 22 more years, being now a Major in the U. S. Army Reserve-Retired-member of First Baptist Church, Atlanta-member of Old War Horse Lawyers Club-former scoutmaster.

#### BOUNDARIES OF 130th DISTRICT

The 130th District is bounded on the east side by the Fulton-DeKalb counties' line from the Georgia Railroad to where one line of the Southern Railway runs across that county line north-east from Lenox Square. Its southern boundary is the Georgia Railroad. It is bounded on the west side by that line of the Southern Railroad, which runs over Ponce de Leon Avenue near Downtown Sears-Roebuck Store, extends near intersection of Piedmont Road and Monroe Drive, and continues on to near the eastern side of Lenox Square, and past it across the DeKalb-Fulton line.

As Mr. Lowe did not learn until the afternoon of April 28th definitely that his name would be on the ballot, he has not had time to have campaign literature printed in a usual manner, and is having to use this substitute method for about two days until he is able to have printing of some literature in regular manner completed.

#### PART OF HIS PLATFORM

He will strive vigorously to help cause Interstate Highway 485 either to by-pass Morningside area, and if that can't be done, help cause it to run in a manner the least injurious to the real property and interests of citizens of the Morningside and Lenox Area as possible. He favors speed in causing rapid transit for Greater Atlanta and early improvement of expressway systems in the Atlanta Area and the state to relieve traffic congestion. Favors improvement of educational systems in the state generally, including better facilities and increase in teachers' salaries-prevention of further usurpation of states rights by federal government-greater efficiency and economy in state government.
