Biographical sketch of Joseph M. Lee III: Author and historian Joseph M. Lee III has collected stereoviews, photographs, postcards and memorabilia of Augusta, Georgia for over 50 years. He has published a postcard history and a photo history of Augusta with Arcadia Publishing. During the 1970s through the 1990s when he worked for the DeKalb County Roads and Drainage Department he collected DeKalb County postcards, maps and other memorabilia that has been donated to the DeKalb History Center. He has been a speaker at past DHC events and served on its Board in 1979 and 1980. Lee is an Augusta, Georgia native and a graduate of Richmond Academy in Augusta. He received a BIE at Georgia Tech in 1960 and a MBA at Georgia State in 1969. He worked at Lockheed-Georgia in engineering and administration for 10 years; at the State of Georgia, Office of the Governor for 2 years; in Real Estate for 2 years and at the DeKalb County Roads and Drainage Department for 25 years before retiring in December 1998 as the Deputy Director for Road Maintenance.

Description: The Joe Lee Collection contains papers from Lee's time working for the DeKalb County Roads and Drainage department and is primarily from the 1970s to the 1990s. There are newspaper clippings of the 1998 Dunwoody tornado and cleanup, the pauper cemetery found on the grounds of the Camp Road facility, the building of the new jail on Memorial Drive and the emergency effort to fix Memorial Drive from the effects of a water main break the day before the Olympic torch relay took the route in July 1996. There are documents on training programs, memoranda, photographs and staff meeting notes.
