## GODDARD FAMILY CEMETERY DeKALB COUNTY GA

This cemetery is near Lithonia GA at the intersection of Union Grove and Rock Chapel Road, diagonally across from the Chupp Cemetery. It is next to the East Lithonia Baptist Church. The Goddard part of the cemetery is within a small stone walled area. The area outside the wall is considered the East Lithonia Baptist Cemetery and is much newer. It has several very recent burials where the Goddard has few.

It is reasonably well maintained except for some weeds and does have some broken stones. The transcription begins to the left if facing the cemetery and moving back down the rows. Asterisks indicate additional info at end of transcription.

The information we have on file for the Goddard Family Cemetery indicates that the cemetery is located near the intersection of Turner Hill Rd., Rock Chapel Rd. and Union Grove Rd. outside of Lithonia.

If you are heading into the area on I-85 North, take I-285 East/North to bypass Atlanta. Follow I-285 to I-20 East. Take I-20 East heading toward Lithonia. Get off of I-20 at the Turner Hill Rd. exit. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Turner Hill Rd. Follow Turner Hill Rd. a short distance. The cemetery should be on the left near the intersection of Turner Hill Rd. and Union Grove Rd. right before Turner Hill Rd. merges with Rock Chapel Rd.
