I read an article recently on the Atlas Obscura website about a "Friends of" group that helps to protect and preserve medieval churches in Britain. They're called the "Friends of Friendless Churches" group. The group was founded in 1957, and ever since, they have been raising money to restore roofs and other things related to dilapidated churches.

The DeKalb History Center was founded in 1947 as the DeKalb Historical Society (and is also dedicated to protecting and preserving) and our "Friends" have been helping us with everything from raising money, to working with visitors, to painting the walls, ever since. Most recently, our Friends helped us raise over \$20,000 for the end-of


-year fundraising campaign. We were able to purchase much needed shelving and supplies for our archives, as well as new shades for several of our archives storage rooms. Thank you all for helping to spread the word and for donating towards our campaign!

Our new shelves and supplies will be used to house a very large collection of materials from the 75 years of the existence of the DeKalb Historical Society, now DeKalb History Center,


DHS Stamp from Ruth Green Collection, 1947.

We're also processing a collection from Dr. Tom Keating related to the Project CLEAN (Citizens, Learners, and Educators Against Neglect) initiative. This collection includes materials that were used in school systems, mostly DeKalb County, to encourage kids and adults to be good stewards of their restrooms and their buildings and to ultimately encourage strong citizenship for all.
