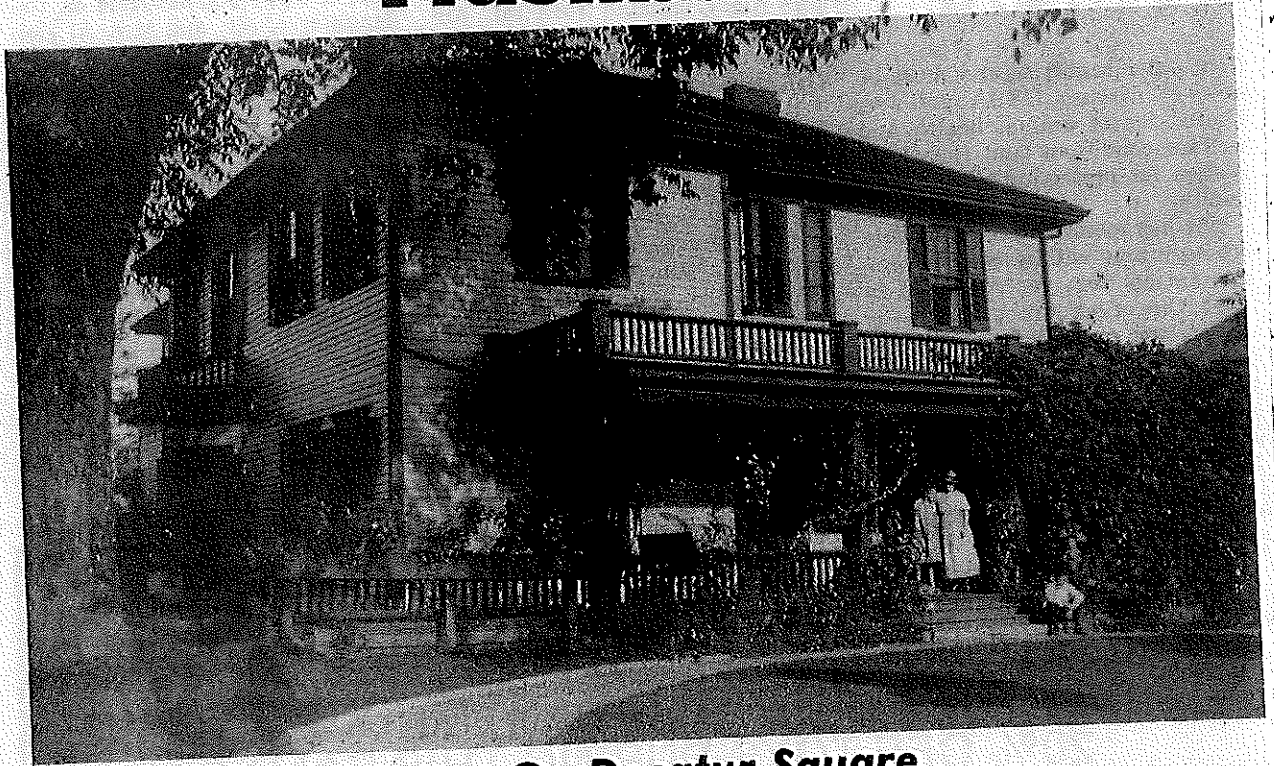

Home On Decatur Square

Reminiscent of the days when dwelling houses ringed the Decatur Square is this home of Mrs. Pearl Everhart. This handsome house replaced a vine-shaded bungalow which was built in 1904 and burned in 1911. This house was located at 6 Clairmont Avenue and it, too, was destroyed by fire in 1927. The A&P Tea Company store then occupied the site until that structure was demolished for the DeKalb Federal building constructed in 1958. Pic-
