

LOCATION:

The Museum of Design Atlanta is conveniently located in the Midtown Arts District, right across the street from the Woodruff Arts Center at 1315 Peachtree St. NE Atlanta, GA 30309. MODA resides on the land of the Mvskoke (Muscogee / Creek) people.

MODA is located on the ground floor of the 1315 Peachtree Building. The building is a mix use site and is shared by MODA, the Peachtree Public Library, and Perkins+Will.

The entrance to MODA is facing Peachtree Street. The door may be locked, but my colleague or I will be there to greet you.

PARKING:

MODA does not offer designated parking. There are public parking lots located in the Midtown Arts district, as well as metered parking available along Peachtree St NE. The paid Lanier parking deck at 1337 Peachtree St NE is the closest deck within walking distance of the museum. (\$8 for 1 hour)

*****Limited Free Parking.** The parking garage below MODA belongs to the Fulton County Public Library. It is accessible from 16th St. The library is located on the floor above MODA. Their parking garage is free, and often has open spots, however spaces are limited and not designated for MODA parking. Park at your own risk.

If you require the elevator (accessible from the parking garage), please contact me ahead of time as it requires a special pass to access the MODA floor. Otherwise, please join us at the main entrance facing Peachtree St.

Marta:

If visiting by train, take the North or South rail line to the Arts Center MARTA Station (N5), located directly behind the Woodruff Arts Center (accessible). Exit the Arts Center Station at the top level by the Peachtree Street exit. You will be behind the Woodruff Arts Center. MODA is located directly across the street from the Woodruff Arts Center. Use the cross-walk at the intersection of 16th and Peachtree to reach our building.
