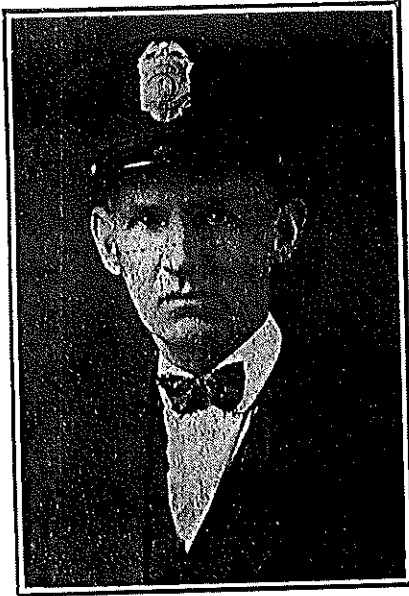

general health conditions of the city. Water supply is adequate and unsurpassed in purity; weekly analysis seldom show an average bacteria count of more than five per cubic centimeter, which is 1-20 the limit of toleration set by American public health authorities.

Among the several manufacturing plants of the city are: Two hosiery mills, one rug manufacturing plant, three monument plants; the largest chair factory in the South, one cotton mill, one locomotive works, one of the most modern and best equipped ice manufacturing plants in the South, and several other smaller industries, all of which furnish employment for a large number of people.

Marietta has been termed a veritable "city of homes." Wide, sweeping avenues, flanked on either side by magnificent water oaks and elms, and a distinctive touch of beauty that is most desired in every city. Nostled in the generous shade of these exceptional gifts of Nature are many snug and comfortable homes, reflecting peace, quiet and happiness.
