DAR - Baron DeKalb Chapter Collection

Scope and content: This collection contains information on the Baron DeKalb Chapter of the D.A.R. It includes meeting minutes from 1912-1938, yearbooks from the late 1940s through the 1970s, ancestor charts for several members, Civil War poems by Geneva Davies, and a citizenship manual for members. The collection also consists of four scrapbooks from the 1930s and the 1950s. Some meeting minutes from the Roswell King Chapter are also included.

Organizational Sketch of the DAR- Baron DeKalb Chapter: The Baron DeKalb Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution was first organized November 22, 1912 in Clarkston, Georgia, at the home of Catherine H. Dillon Shepherd. The chapter is named for "a German-born patriot who volunteered for the colonists and fought with General Washington at Valley Forge." Baron Jean de Kalb lead Maryland and Delaware troops during the American Revolution and after his horse was shot from under him, he led his men on foot. De Kalb died in Camden, South Carolina and DeKalb County, Georgia is named for him. In 1926, the group moved from Clarkston to Decatur and has been involved in many volunteer activities, including serving as scout leaders and nurses' aides. They helped the Scottish Rite Hospital, Lawson Hospital, Red Cross and local libraries and schools. The Baron DeKalb chapter has presented flags to area schools and planted trees.

Description: The Baron DeKalb Chapter Collection contains scrapbooks, early printers' non-bound copies of *The Colonial Records of Georgia*, members' ancestry charts, meeting minutes, *National DAR News* and organization events.
