STARTING HER SECOND CENTURY OF LIFE

That grand old lady of Gwinnett County, Mrs. G. S. Kelley, has passed her 102nd birthday.

Alert and in fair health, she gets about at her home on Perry Street in Lawrenceville, aided by her daughter, 73-year-old Myrtis Kelley, who has been her mother's constant companion for 24 years.

Mrs. Kelley, the mother of a distinguished family, was born February 7, 1867, and has lived most of her long life in Gwinnett County. Her husband, Dr. Giles Kelley who died in 1927, was one of the pioneer physicians in the county, whose work was carried on by their son, Dr. D. C. Kelley, now 81 and retired to his home in Lawrenceville.

Joining in the celebration of their mother's 102nd birthday at her home this past February 7, were Myrtis, Dr. Kelley, and three other well-known sons, all retired, Judge Fred Kelley, 78, of Gainesville, Ga.; John I, Kelley, 76, of Atlanta, former solicitor of Fulton criminal court; and Paul Kelley, Sr., 75, former businessman of Lawrenceville.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENTS

A new \$12 million mall-type regional shopping center is planned on a 78 acre tract, 600 feet north of the Perimeter Highway (I-285) and extending northerly along the Ashford-Dunwoody Road. It borders Chamblee and Doraville.

The DeKalb Board of Education is seeking to acquire a 119 acre site at Womack Road and Tilly Mill Road, north of Doraville, for an elementary school, a vocational-technical school and the north campus of the DeKalb Community College.

Construction work is underway on a \$2,500,000 combination office-warehouse facility in the Montreal Industrial district by Scott, Foresman and Company, publisher of textbooks for elementary high school and college use.

A new 1968 Population and Housing Report issued by the Atlanta Region Metropolitan Planning Commission places DeKalb's population at 353,500, compared to 86,943 in 1940. The county has added an average of 12,000 persons a year since 1960, which compares with an average of 7,553 a year in Cobb County and 6,157 in Fulton.
