GREENVILLE HENDERSON CEMETERY
DeKALB COUNTY GA

This cemetery is located in the middle of a subdivision off Henderson Mill Rd in Tucker, GA. It's land lot #249, 18th district. To access the cemetery, turn from Henderson Mill Road onto Glenrose Drive (there is only one way to turn). From there turn left onto Glenrose Hill and go all the way to the cul-de-sac. There is an access between two houses in the cul-de-sac. The cemetery is behind one of the houses and approx. 126' by 116'.

When Franklin Garrett transcribed it in 1931, there were 19 marked graves and several unmarked. Today there are still that number despite the fact that at least one burial occurred in 1934, after Garrett's transcription. Several of the marked graves are only in fragments.

"We hope to make it a place of beauty as well as a place to play." So spoke the Rev. Randy Pollard of Harmony Grove Methodist Church as he enthusiastically explained to Roy E. Hutchens, Eagle Editor, the plans for a 16-acre community park, purchased and being developed by the Lilburn Lions Club.

It's a dream coming true.

Aiding in the project, Gwinnett County officials have provided engineering service and done the grading on the property, located between Harmony Grove Road and Rockbridge Road directly behind Harmony Grove Estates.

Already laid out are regulation fields for little league baseball, pee wee football, and softball and baseball for high schoolers and adults. To follow are tennis courts, basketball court, small children's play area, picnic area and Scout huts. Long range plans include a community building, library and swimming pool. There will be plenty of parking areas.

The University of Georgia is helping with landscaping plans, which will include as many varieties of trees and shrubs as possible.

The park and playground, near Lilburn, will serve a large and growing area between Tucker and Lawrenceville.

"We hope in the years ahead the park will become a community-wide center for civic groups and garden clubs," Mr. Pollard said.

The park and its facilities will be free to residents of the community. Since the cost of development will be considerable, donations are being asked, with checks payable to Lilburn Lions Club, Incorporated.



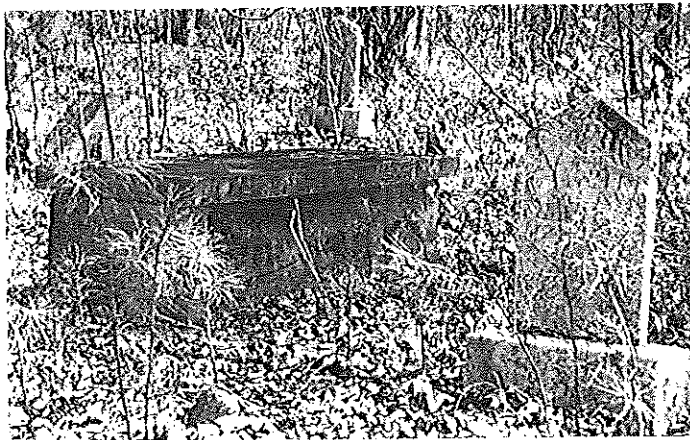
"The words expressly are, 'a pound of flesh'

The above-ground concrete vault has this inscription: "Greenville Henderson, born Nov. 10, 1792, died August 14, 1869."

As automobiles roar along a nearby highway and planes split the air overhead, Greenville Henderson, born 174 years ago, sleeps eternally in a wood-tangled little cemetery off Henderson Mill Road.

Buried near this hardy pioneer of the Tucker-Chamblee area are about 30 relatives, including his wife, Nancy, who died in 1892 at the age of 102.

Below the white section are the graves of 40 Negro slaves who served Greenville Henderson and his family faithfully on his 3,000-acre plantation, which encompassed the area from Tucker to below the WSB radio tower and from Lawrenceville Highway to Henderson Mill Road.

The almost-forgotten cemetery, surrounded by \$30,000 to \$50,000 homes, rests on a two-acre knoll between Midvale and Henderson roads, and is owned by the Henderson heirs. Six generations of Hendersons have resided in the Tucker area. Among those well known today are Greenville's great grandson, Marcus G. Henderson, 77, and his great great grandsons.

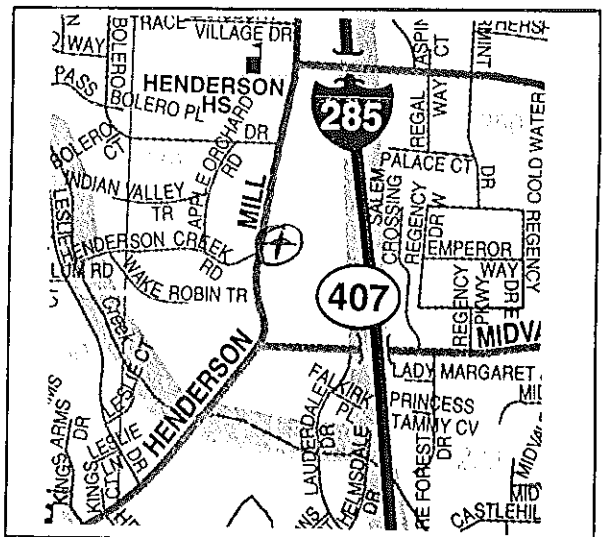
